### ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** = Approximately

**Beg** = Beginning

**Cont** = Continue(ity)

**Dec** = Decreas(e)(ing)

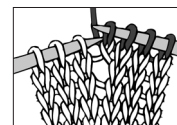
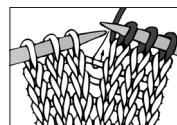
**Inc** = Inceas(ed)(ing)

**K** = Knit

**K2tog** = Knit next 2 stitches together

**Kfb** = Increase 1 stitch by knitting into front and back loop of next stitch

**M1** = Make 1 stitch by picking up horizontal loop lying before next stitch and knitting into back of loop.



**Rem** = Remain(ing)

**Rep(s)** = Repeat(s)

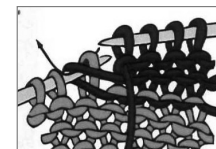
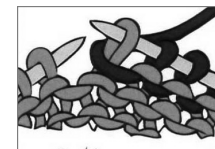
**RS** = Right side

**Sl1 pwyif** = Slip next stitch purlwise, with yarn held in front

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**Tog** = Together

**W&T** = Bring yarn to front of work. Slip next stitch purlwise. Bring yarn to back of work. Slip stitch back onto left-hand needle. Turn.



**WS** = Wrong side

### MATERIALS

Caron® x Pantone™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 127 yds/116 m)

#### Version 1

**Main Color (MC)** Dane Gray (01003) **4 braids**

**Blushing Coral** (01033) **2 braids**

#### Version 2

**Main Color (MC)** Coconut Cream (01001) **4 braids**

**Blushing Coral** (01033) **2 braids**

Size U.S. 10 (6 mm) circular knitting needle 29" [73.5 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

### MEASUREMENTS

Approx 25" [63.5 cm] wide (at widest point) x 75" [190.5 cm] long.

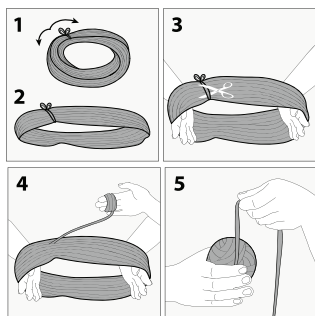
### GAUGE

14 sts and 26 rows = 4" [10 cm] in garter stitch.

## INSTRUCTIONS

### Notes:

- Before working with Caron x Pantone multi-shade yarn braid, separate each color link and wind into 5 separate balls.



- Each color link will be referenced by its Pantone # (see ball band).
- Designate each different shade of the 5 separate yarn balls as Contrast A, B, C, D and E as noted in Materials section (or as desired).
- Due to finite amount of yarn in each shade, pattern gauge must be matched to ensure successful results.

With MC, cast on 3 sts.

**1st row:** (RS). K2. Kfb. 4 sts.

**2nd row:** Knit.

**3rd row:** Knit to last st. M1. K1. 5 sts.

**4th row:** Knit.

Rep last 2 rows to 12 sts, ending on a WS row. (9 garter ridges on RS).

**First Diamond Wedge: 1st row:** (RS). With A, knit to last st. Kfb. 13 sts. 1 st inc.

**2nd row:** K2. W&T. Leave rem sts unworked.

**3rd row:** K1. Kfb. **Turn.** 14 sts. 1 st inc.

**4th row:** K4. W&T. Leave rem sts unworked.

**5th row:** Knit to last st. Kfb. 15 sts. 1 st inc.

**6th row:** K6. W&T. Leave rem sts unworked.

**7th row:** Knit to last st. Kfb. 16 sts. 1 st inc.

**8th row:** K8. W&T. Leave rem sts unworked.

**9th row:** Knit to last st. Kfb. 17 sts. 1 st inc.

**10th row:** Cast off 1 st. K6. W&T. 16 sts. 1 st dec.

**11th row:** K7.

**12th row:** Cast off 1 st. K4. W&T. 15 sts. 1 st dec.

**13th row:** K5.

**14th row:** Cast off 1 st. K2. W&T. 14 sts. 1 st dec.

**15th row:** K3.

**16th row:** Cast off 1 st. W&T. 13 sts. 1 st dec.

**17th row:** K1.

**18th row:** Cast off 1 st. Knit to end of row, picking up wrap, placing it on left-hand needle and knitting next st tog with wrap for each of first 4 sts. 12 sts.

**Next row:** With MC, knit to last st. M1. K1. 13 sts. 1 st inc.

**Next row:** Knit.

Rep last 2 rows 5 times more. 18 sts. (6 garter ridges on RS).

**\*\*Diamond Wedge: 1st row: Do not** break MC. With B, knit to last st. Kfb. 1 st inc.

**2nd row:** K2. W&T. Leave rem sts unworked.

**3rd row:** K1. Kfb. Turn. 1 st inc.

**4th row:** K4. W&T. Leave rem sts unworked.

**5th row:** Knit to last st. Kfb. 1 st inc.

**6th row:** K6. W&T. Leave rem sts unworked.

**7th row:** Knit to last st. Kfb. 1 st inc.

**8th row:** K8. W&T. Leave rem sts unworked.

**9th row:** Knit to last st. Kfb. 1 st inc.

**10th row:** Cast off 1 st. K6. W&T. 1 st dec.

**11th row:** K7.

**12th row:** Cast off 1 st. K4. W&T. 1 st dec.

**13th row:** K5.

**14th row:** Cast off 1 st. K2. W&T. 1 st dec.

**15th row:** K3.

**16th row:** Cast off 1 st. W&T. 1 st dec.

**17th row:** K1.

**18th row:** Cast off 1 st. Knit to end of row, picking up wrap, placing it on left-hand needle and knitting next st tog with wrap for each of first 4 sts. 1 st dec.\*\*\*

**Next row:** (RS). With MC, knit to last st. M1. K1. 1 st inc.

**Next row:** Knit.

Rep last 2 rows 5 times more. (6 garter ridges on RS).\*\*

Work from \*\* to \*\* 12 times more, working Diamond Wedges in the following sequence: C, D, E, A, B, then work from \*\* to \*\*\* once, ending with a Diamond Wedge section worked in E. 96 sts.

**Beg decs: 1st row:** With MC, knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 1 st dec.

**2nd row:** Knit.

Rep last 2 rows 5 times more. 90 sts.

\*\*\*\***Diamond Wedge: 1st row:** Do not break MC. With A, knit to last st. Kfb. 1 st inc.  
**2nd row:** K2. W&T. Leave rem sts unworked.  
**3rd row:** K1. Kfb. Turn. 1 st inc.  
**4th row:** K4. W&T. Leave rem sts unworked.  
**5th row:** Knit to last st. Kfb. 1 st inc.  
**6th row:** K6. W&T. Leave rem sts unworked.  
**7th row:** Knit to last st. Kfb. 1 st inc.  
**8th row:** K8. W&T. Leave rem sts unworked.  
**9th row:** Knit to last st. Kfb. 1 st inc.  
**10th row:** Cast off 1 st. K6. W&T. 1 st dec.  
**11th row:** K7.  
**12th row:** Cast off 1 st. K4. W&T. 1 st dec.  
**13th row:** K5.  
**14th row:** Cast off 1 st. K2. W&T. 1 st dec.  
**15th row:** K3.  
**16th row:** Cast off 1 st. W&T. 1 st dec.  
**17th row:** K1.  
**18th row:** Cast off 1 st. Knit to end of row, picking up wrap, placing it on left-hand needle and knitting next st tog with wrap for each of first 4 sts. 1 st dec.

**Next row:** With MC, knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 1 st dec.  
**Next row:** Knit.  
 Rep last 2 rows 5 times more.\*\*\*\*

Work from \*\*\*\* to \*\*\*\* 12 times more, working Diamond Wedges in following sequence: B, C, D, E, A. 12 sts.

With MC, cont dec 1 st every RS (alt row) to 3 sts.  
**Next row:** K1. K2tog. 2 sts.  
**Next row:** K2tog. Fasten off.
