# KNIT I SKILLLEVEL: EASY

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

Approx = Approximately **Cont** = Continue(ity) **K** = Knit **K2tog** = Knit next 2 stitches together

- $\mathbf{Kfb} = \text{Increase 1}$ stitch by knitting into front and back of next stitch **Kfbf** = Increase 2 stitches by knitting into front, back, and front of next stitch
- Pat = Pattern  $\mathbf{P} = Purl$ **Rep** = Repeat **RS** = Right side **St(s)** = Stitch(es) **WS** = Wrong side

### **MEASUREMENTS**

Approx 29<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"x 70" [75 x 178 cm].

### GAUGE

18 sts and 22 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking stitch.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

#### Notes:

Before working with Caron<sup>®</sup> x Pantone<sup>™</sup> Bamboo<sup>™</sup> multi-shade varn braid, separate each color link and wind into 5 separate balls.



- Each color link will be referenced by its Pantone # (see ball band)
- Designate each different shade of the 5 separate yarn balls as Contrast A, B, C, D and E as noted in Materials section (or as desired).
- Due to finite amount of yarn in each shade, pattern gauge must be matched to ensure successful results.

### **Stripe Pat**

\*\*\*With A, work 12 rows. With B, work 12 rows. With C, work 12 rows. With D, work 24 rows. With C, work 12 rows.

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## CARON<sup>®</sup> SMOOTH STRIPES KNIT SHAWL | KNIT

With B, work 12 rows. With A, work 12 rows.\*\*\* Rep last 96 rows once more. With E, work 2 rows. \*\*With A, work 2 rows. With E, work 2 rows. With B, work 2 rows. With E, work 2 rows. With C, work 2 rows. With C, work 2 rows. With D, work 2 rows. With D, work 2 rows. With E, work 2 rows. With E, work 2 rows. With E, work 2 rows. These 386 rows form Stripe Pat.

With A, cast on 1 st. 1st row: (RS). Kfbf. 3 sts. 2nd row: Knit. 3rd row: K1. Kfbf. K1. 5 sts. 4th row: Knit. 5th row: K2. Kfbf. K2. 7 sts. 6th row: K3. P1. K3. 7th row: K3. Kfb. Knit to end of row. 8 sts. 8th row: K3. Purl to last 3 sts. K3. 9th row: As 7th row. 9 sts. 10th row: K3. Purl to last 3 sts. K3. 11th row K3. Kfb. K2tog. K3. 9 sts. 12th row: K3. Purl to last 3 sts. K3. Break A. Join B. 13th row: With B, K3. Kfb. Knit to end of row. 10 sts.

14th row: K3. Purl to last 3 sts. K3.
15th row: As 13th row. 11 sts.
16th row: K3. Purl to last 3 sts. K3
17th row K3. Kfb. Knit to last 5 sts.
K2tog. K3. 11 sts.
18th row: K3. Purl to last 3 sts. K3.

First 18 rows of Stripe Pat are complete. Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, rep 13th to 18th rows 60 times more, ending on a 18th row pat rep. 131 sts. **379th to 382nd rows:** As 13th to 16th rows. 133 sts. **383rd to 386th rows:** Knit. Cast off.
