## Caron ${ }^{\circledR}$ Simply Soft ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ Paints ${ }^{\text {™ }}$ ( $5 \mathrm{oz} / 141 \mathrm{~g} ; 235 \mathrm{yds} / 215 \mathrm{~m}$ ) <br> Contrast A Sunset (21005) <br> 1 ball <br> Contrast B Sunset Autumn (21014) <br> 1 ball <br> Contrast C Spring Brook (21003) <br> 2 balls <br> Contrast D Oceana (21004) 2 balls <br> Contrast E Peacock Feather (21007) 2 balls

Size U.S. 8 ( 5 mm ) circular knitting needle 29" [75 cm] long or size needed to obtain gauge. Stitch marker.
(c40) Kignit I Skill level: intermediate

## ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately
Center dec (worked over 3 sts)
= Slip next 2 stitches together as
if to knit them together. K1. Pass 2
slipped stitches over knit stitch
Cont = Continue(ity)
K = Knit
K2tog $=$ Knit next 2 stitches together
$\mathbf{K f b}=$ Increase 1 stitch by knitting into front and back of next stitch $\mathbf{P}=$ Purl

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 42" [106.5 cm ] deep x 65" [168 cm] long

## GAUGE

17 sts and 32 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in garter stitch.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Notes: Work back and forth across circular needle in rows.
Move marker onto center dec st as each row progresses.
Measure work along center decrease line.

Pat $=$ Pattern
PM = Place marker
Rem = Remain(ing)
Rep $=$ Repeat
RS $=$ Right side
SI1Pwyif = Slip 1 stitch purlwise
with yarn in front
St(s) = Stitch(es)
WS = Wrong side
Yo = yarn over

## Stripe Pat A

With A, work 14" [ 35.5 cm ], ending on a WS row.
*With B, work 2 rows. With A, work 2 rows.*
Rep from * to * for 6" [15 cm], ending with 2 rows of A. With B, work 8" [20.5 cm], ending on a WS row.
**With C, work 2 rows. With B, work 2 rows.**
Rep from ** to ** for 4" [10 cm], ending with 2 rows of B .
With C, work 8" [20.5 cm], ending on a WS row.

## CROM OCEAN SUNSET KNIT SHAWL

***With D, work 2 rows. With C, Keeping cont of Stripe Pat A, work 2 rows.***
Rep from ${ }^{* * *}$ to ${ }^{* * *}$ for 4 " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ], ending with 2 rows of $C$.
With D, work 5" [12.5 cm], ending on a WS row.
These rows complete Stripe Pat A.

## Stripe Pat B

With D, work 3" [7.5 cm], ending on a WS row.
****With D, work 2 rows. With E, work 2 rows.****
Rep from ${ }^{* * * *}$ to ${ }^{* * * *}$ for 4 " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$, ending with 2 rows of $E$.
With E only, work to end of Shawl.

## SHAWL

With A, cast on 1 st.
1 st row: (RS). (K1. yo. K1) all in st. 3 sts.
2nd row: K1. P1. K1.
3rd row: Kfb. K1. Kfb. 5 sts.
4th row: K2. Sl1Pwyif. K2.
5th row: Kfb. Center dec. PM on last st. Kfb. 5 sts.
6th row: Kfb. K1. SI1Pwyif (marked st). K2.
First 6 rows of Stripe Pat A are now complete.
proceed as follows:
7th row: Kfb. Knit to last 2 sts. Kfb. K1.
8th row: Knit to marked st. SI1Pwyif. Knit to end of row.
9th row: Kfb. Knit to 1 st before marked st. Center dec. PM on last st. Knit to last 2 sts. Kfb. K1.
10th row: Kfb. Knit to marked st. SI1Pwyif. Knit to end of row.
Rep 7th to 10th rows until Stripe Pat $A$ is complete, ending on 10th row.

Proceed in Stripe Pat B as follows: 1st row: (RS). K2tog. Knit to last 2 sts. Kfb. K1.
2nd row: Knit to marked st. SI1Pwyif. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog. 3nd row: K2tog. Knit to 1 st before marked st. Center dec. PM on last st. Knit to last 2 sts. Kfb. K1.
4th row: Kfb. Knit to marked st. SI1Pwyif. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog.

Rep last 4 rows and cont in Stripe Pat B, until all sts before marked st (center dec) have been cast off, ending on a WS row. Cast off all rem sts.
