## CRO RADIANT RAYS KNIT WRAP



## MATERIALS

Caron ${ }^{\circledR}$ Simply Soft ${ }^{\oplus}$ (6 oz/170.1 g; 315 yds/288 m)
Main Color (MC) Off White (9702) 3 balls or 896 yds/819 m
Contrast A Bone (9703)
Contrast B Pumpkin (9765)
Contrast C Gold (9782)
Contrast D Chartreuse (9771)
Contrast E Soft Green (9739)
Size U.S. $8(5 \mathrm{~mm})$ circular knitting needle 29 " $[73.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] long or size needed to obtain gauge. Yarn needle.

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 31" [78.5 cm] deep x 70" [178 cm] wide.

## GAUGE

17 sts and 32 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in garter stitch.

RS $=$ Right side
St(s) = Stitch(es)
Tog = Together
$\mathbf{W} \boldsymbol{Q} \mathbf{T}=$ Bring yarn to front of work. Slip next stitch purlwise. Bring yarn to back of work. Slip stitch back onto left-hand needle. Turn.


WS $=$ Wrong side

## INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Shawl is worked from side to side.

## SHAWL

With MC, cast on 3 sts.
1st row: (RS). K2. Kfb. 4 sts. 1 st inc. 2nd row: Knit.

3rd row: Knit to last st. M1. K1. 5 sts. 1 st inc.
4th row: Knit.
Rep last 2 rows to 14 sts, ending on a WS row. (11 garter ridges on RS).

## First Diamond Wedge:

Inc Rows: 1 st row: (RS). Do not break MC. With A, knit to last st. Kfb. 15 sts. 1 st inc.
2nd row: K2. W\&T. Leave rem sts unworked.
3rd row: K1. Kfb. Turn. 16 sts. 1 st inc.
4th row: K4. W\&T. Leave rem sts unworked.
5th row: Knit to last st. Kfb. 17 sts. 1 st inc.
6th row: K6. W\&T. Leave rem sts unworked.
7th row: Knit to last st. Kfb. 18 sts. 1 st inc.
8th row: K8. W\&T. Leave rem sts unworked.
9th row: Knit to last st. Kfb. 19 sts.
1 st inc.
10th row: K10.W\&T. Leave rem sts unworked
11th row: Knit to last st. Kfb. 20 sts.
1 st inc.

Dec Rows: 12th row: Cast off 1 st. K8. W\&T. 19 sts. 1 st dec.
13th row: K9.
14th row: Cast off 1 st. K6. W\&T.
18 sts. 1 st dec.
15th row: K7.
16th row: Cast off 1 st. K4. W\&T.
17 sts. 1 st dec.
17th row: K5.
18th row: Cast off 1 st. K2. W\&T.
16 sts. 1 st dec.
19th row: K3.
20th row: Cast off 1 st. W\&T. 15 sts. 1 st dec.
21st row: K1.
22nd row: Cast off 1 st. Knit to end of row, picking up wrap, placing it on left-hand needle and knitting next st tog with wrap for each of first 4 sts. 14 sts. Break A.

Next row: (RS). With MC, knit to last st. M1. K1. 15 sts. 1 st inc.
Next row: (WS). Knit.
Rep last 2 rows 6 times more. 21 sts. (7 garter ridges on RS).
**Diamond Wedge: 1 st row: (RS).
Do not break MC. With B, knit to last st. Kfb. 1 st inc.
2nd row: K2. W\&T. Leave rem sts unworked.
3rd row: K1. Kfb. Turn. 1 st inc.

4th row: K4. W\&T. Leave rem sts unworked.
5th row: Knit to last st. Kfb. 1 st inc. 6th row: K6. W\&T. Leave rem sts unworked.
7th row: Knit to last st. Kfb. 1 st inc.
8th row: K8. W\&T. Leave rem sts unworked.
9th row: Knit to last st. Kfb. 1 st inc.
10th row: K10. W\&T. Leave rem sts unworked.
11th row: Knit to last st. Kfb. 1 st inc.
12th row: Cast off 1 st. K8. W\&T.
1 st dec.
13th row: K9.
14th row: Cast off 1 st. K6. W\&T. 1 st dec.
15th row: K7.
16th row: Cast off 1 st. K4. W\&T. 1 st dec.
17th row: K5.
18th row: Cast off 1 st. K2. W\&T. 1 st dec.
19th row: K3.
20th row: Cast off 1 st. W\&T. 1 st dec.
21st row: K1.
22nd row: Cast off 1 st. Knit to end of row, picking up wrap, placing it on left-hand needle and knitting next st tog with wrap for each of first 4 sts. 1 st dec. Break B.***

Next row: (RS). With MC, knit to last st. M1. K1. 1 st inc.
Next row: (WS). Knit.
Rep last 2 rows 6 times more. (7 garter ridges on RS).**

Work from ** to ** 14 times more, working Diamond Wedges in following sequence: C, D, E, A, B, then work from ${ }^{* *}$ to ${ }^{* * *}$ once, ending with Diamond Wedge section worked in B. 126 sts.

Beg dec: ****1st row: With MC, knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 1 st dec. 2nd row: Knit.
Rep last 2 rows 6 times more. 119 sts.

Diamond Wedge: 1 st row: (RS). Do not break MC. With A, knit to last st. Kfb. 1 st inc.
2nd row: K2. W\&T. Leave rem sts unworked.
3rd row: K1. Kfb. Turn. 1 st inc.
4th row: K4. W\&T. Leave rem sts unworked.
5th row: Knit to last st. Kfb. 1 st inc. 6th row: K6. W\&T. Leave rem sts unworked.
7th row: Knit to last st. Kfb. 1 st inc. 8th row: K8. W\&T. Leave rem sts unworked.

## 'Zarnspirations" <br> spark your inspiration!

9th row: Knit to last st. Kfb. 1 st inc. Next row: (RS). With MC, knit to last 10th row: K10. W\&T. Leave rem sts unworked.
11th row: Knit to last st. Kfb. 1 st inc.
12th row: Cast off 1 st. K8. W\&T. 1 st dec.
13th row: K9.
14th row: Cast off 1 st. K6. W\&T. 1 st dec.
15th row: K7.
16th row: Cast off 1 st. K4. W\&T. 1 st dec.
17th row: K5.
18th row: Cast off 1 st. K2. W\&T. 1 st dec.
19th row: K3.
20th row: Cast off 1 st. W\&T. 1 st dec.
21st row: K1.
22nd row: Cast off 1 st. Knit to end of row, picking up wrap, placing it on left-hand needle and knitting next st tog with wrap for each of first 4 sts. 1 st dec.****

Work from ${ }^{* * * *}$ to ${ }^{* * * *} 15$ times more, working Diamond Wedges in following sequence:
E, D, C, B, A. 14 sts.

3 sts. K2tog. K1. 1 st dec.
Next row: (WS). Knit.
Rep last 2 rows, dec 1 st every RS (alt row) to 3 sts.
Next row: K1. K2tog. 2 sts.
Next row: K2tog. Fasten off.
