



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx =

Approximately

Cont = Continuity

K = Knit

Kfb = Increase

1 stitch by knitting into front and back of next stitch.

K2(3)tog = Knit next 2(3) stitches together

Pat = Pattern

Rem = Remain

Rep = Repeat

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 22" [56 cm] wide x 70" [178 cm] long.

GAUGE

10 sts and 18 rows = 4" [10 cm] in garter stitch.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- Wrap is worked corner to corner.
- Work back and forth across needle in rows.

Stripe Pat

With A, work 20 rows.

With B, work 20 rows.

These 40 rows form Stripe Pat.

WRAP

With A, cast on 3 sts.

Increase rows:

1st row: (WS). Knit.

2nd row: Kfb. Knit to last st. Kfb. 5 sts.

First 2 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, rep last 2 rows until bottom edge measures 22" [56 cm], ending on a 2nd row.

Center Section:

1st row: (WS). Knit.

2nd row: K2tog. Knit to last st. Kfb. Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, rep last 2 rows until long (side) edge measures 70" [178 cm] long, ending on a 2nd row.

MATERIALS

Caron® Tea Cakes™ (8.5 oz/240 g; 204 yds/186 m)

Contrast A Sunset Stroll (20044) **2 cakes**

Contrast B Marine Green (20040) **2 cakes**

Size U.S. 15 (10 mm) circular knitting needle 29" [73.5 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Yarn needle.

Decrease rows:

1st row: (WS). Knit.

2nd row: K2tog. Knit to last 2 sts.

K2tog.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, rep last 2 rows until 3 sts rem.

Next row: Knit.

Next row: K3tog. Fasten off.
