GAUGE


20 sts and 26 rows = 4" [10 cm] with larger needles in stocking stitch.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

Notes:

Before working with Caron® x
 Pantone™ Bamboo™ multi-shade
 yarn braid, separate each color link
 and wind into 5 separate balls.



- Due to finite amount of yarn in each shade, pattern gauge must be matched to ensure successful results.
- Cardigan is worked in one piece to armholes.
- When working from charts, carry colors not in use loosely across WS of row, but never over more than 3 sts. When it must pass over more than 5 sts, weave it over and under color in use. The colors are never twisted around one another.

BODY

With smaller circular needle and A, cast on 182 (210-222-250-278-318) sts. **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:

1st row: (RS). *K2. P2. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K2.

2nd row: *P2. K2. Rep from * to last 2 sts. P2.

Rep last 2 rows of (K2. P2) ribbing for 3" [7.5 cm], ending on a 2nd row.

Next row: (RS). Knit, inc **0** (2-2-4-0-2) sts evenly across. **182** (212-224-254-278-320) sts.

Change to larger circular needle. Beg on a purl row, work even in stocking st until work from beg measures 4" [10 cm], ending on a purl row.

Work Chart (see page 4) in stocking st to end of chart, reading RS rows from *right* to *left* and WS rows from *left* to *right*, noting 6-st rep will be worked 30 (35-37-42-46-53) times. Break A, B, C, D, E, F.

With MC, cont even in stocking st until piece from beg measures 12" [30.5 cm], ending on a purl row.

Divide for Right Front: K**46** (**54**-**56**-**64**-**70**-**82**). **Turn**. Leave rem sts on spare needle.

Shape armhole and neck: 1st row: (WS). Cast off **4** (6-6-6-10-14) sts. Purl to end of row. **42** (**48-50-58-60-68**) sts.

Sizes XL, 2/3XL and 4/5XL only: Next row: (RS). Knit.

Next row: Cast off (6-10-14) sts. Purl to end of row. (52-50-54) sts.

All sizes: Next row: (RS). K1. ssk. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1.

Next row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows **4** (**5-6-6-8-10**) times more. **32** (**36-36-38-32-32**) sts.

Cont in stocking st, dec 1 st at neck edge only on next and every following alt row to 18 (22-24-24-24) sts.

Cont even until armhole measures 7½ (8-8-8½-9-10)" [19 (20.5-20.5-22.5-23-25.5) cm], ending on a knit row.

Shape shoulder: Cast off **9** (11-12-12-12) sts at beg of next and following alt row.

Back: With RS facing and larger circular needle, join MC to next unworked st.

Shape armholes: Cast off **4** (6-6-6-10-14) sts. K**86** (98-106-120-128-142). **Turn**. Leave rem sts on spare needle.

Next row: Cast off 4 (6-6-6-10-14) sts. Purl to end of row. 82 (92-100-114-118-128) sts.

Sizes XL, 2/3XL and 4/5XL only: Next row: (RS). Cast off (6-10-14) sts. Knit to end of row.

Next row: Cast off (6-10-14) sts. Purl to end of row. (102-98-100) sts.

All sizes: Next row: (RS). K1. ssk. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1.

Next row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows **4** (**5-6-6-3-3**) times more. **72** (**80-86-88-90-92**) sts.

Cont even until armholes measure same length as Right Front before shoulder shaping, ending on a purl row. **Shape shoulders:** Cast off **9** (11-12-12-12) sts beg next 4 rows. Cast off rem **36** (**36-38-40-42-44**) sts.

Left Front: With RS facing and larger circular needle, join MC to next unworked st.

Shape armhole and neck:

Cast off **4** (6-6-6-10-14) sts. Knit to end of row. **42** (48-50-58-60-68) sts.

Sizes XL, 2/3XL and 4/5XL only: Next row: (WS). Purl

Next row: Cast off (6-10-14) sts. Purl to end of row. (52-50-54) sts.

All sizes: 1st row: (WS). Purl. **2nd row:** (RS). K1. ssk. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1.

3rd row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows **4** (**5-6-6-8-10**) times more. **32** (**36-36-38-32-32**) sts.

Cont in stocking st, dec 1 st at neck edge only on next and every following alt row to 18 (22-24-24-24) sts.

Cont even until armhole measures same length as Right Front before shoulder shaping, ending on a purl row.

Shape shoulder: Cast off **9** (11-12-12-12) sts at beg of next and following alt row.

SLEEVES

With smaller needles and A, cast on **50** (**50-54-54-62-66**) sts. Work 2" [5 cm] in (K2. P2) ribbing as given for Body, ending on a RS row.

Next row: (WS). Purl, inc 0 (0-2-2-0-2) sts evenly across. 50 (50-56-56-62-68) sts.

Change to larger needles. Work Chart in stocking st to end of chart, noting 6-st rep will be worked **8** (8-9-9-10-11) times. Break A, B, C, D, E and F.

With MC, cont in stocking st, inc 1 st at each end of next and every 6th (4th-4th-4th-2nd-2nd) row 8 (11-10-11-7-7) times total. 66 (72-76-78-76-82) sts.

Sizes 2/3XL and 4/5XL only: Inc 1 st at each end of every following 4th row 7 times more. 90 (96) sts. All sizes: 66 (72-76-78-90-96) sts. Cont even in stocking st until work from beg measures 12½" [32 cm], ending on a purl row.

Shape top: Cast off **4** (6-6-6-10-14) sts beg next 2 rows. **58** (60-64-66-70-68) sts.

1st row: (RS). K1. ssk. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1.

2nd row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows to **26** (**26-28-28-30-30**) sts.
Cast off.

FINISHING

Pin garment pieces to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth, leaving cloth to dry. Sew shoulder seams.

Button and Buttonhole Band: With A and smaller needles, cast on 7 sts.

1st row: (RS). K2. (P1. K1) twice. K1.

2nd row: K1. (P1. K1) 3 times. Rep last 2 rows until Band, when slightly stretched, measures length to fit up Left Front, sewing in place as you knit, and changing colors to correspond to color change in Cardigan and matching Chart. Place markers on band for

6 buttons, having bottom button $\frac{1}{2}$ " [1.5 cm] above cast on edge, top button $\frac{1}{2}$ " [1.5 cm] below first front dec and rem 4 buttons spaced evenly between.

Cont in ribbing to fit up neck edge, across back neck edge and down opposite neck edge to first button marker.

Make buttonholes as follows:

1st row: (RS). Rib 3 sts. Cast off


2 sts. Rib 2 sts.

2nd row: Rib, casting on 2 sts

over cast off sts.

Cont in ribbing to end of Right Front, being sure to change colors to correspond to color changes in Cardigan and matching Chart. Cast off in ribbing.

Sew Sleeve seams. Sew in Sleeves.
Sew buttons to correspond to 19½ buttonholes.
