MATERIALS

Caron® Marble Cakes™ (8.5 oz/240 g; 404 yds/369 m))

Sizes XS/S M XL 2/3XL 4/5XL

Rosewater Plum (210030) balls

Sizes U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) and U.S. 8 (5 mm) circular knitting needles 16" [40.5 cm] and 36" [91.5 cm] long. Sets of 4 sizes U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) and U.S. 8 (5 mm) double-pointed knitting needles or sizes needed to obtain gauge. Stitch markers.





ABBREVIATIONS

Beg = Beginning

Dec = Decrease

Inc = Increase

Rnd(s) = Round(s)**SM** = Slip marker **Ssk** = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto lefthand needle, then knit through back loops together **St(s)** = Stitch(es)

SIZES

To fit bust measurement

28/34" (71/86.5 cm) XS/S M 36/38" (91.5/96.5 cm) L 40/42" (101.5/106.5 cm) 44/46" (112/117 cm) XL 48/54" (122/137 cm) 2/3XL

56/62" (142/157.5) 4/5XL

Finished bust measurement

XS/S 38" (96.5 cm) 42" (106.5 cm) 46" (117 cm) 50" (127 cm) XL 2/3XL 56" (142 cm) 64" (162.5 cm) 4/5XL

GAUGE

18 sts and 24 rows = 4'' [10 cm] in stocking st on larger needles.



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INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus ().

Notes: Sweater is worked in 1 piece from neck edge down. Neck shaping is worked in rows. After center front sts are cast on, work is joined and completed in the round.

BODY

Beg at neck edge with larger, shorter circular needle, cast on **58** (**64-64-66-66-72**) sts.

1st row: (RS). K1. PM. K1. PM. K10 (12-12-12-14). PM. K1. PM. K32 (34-34-36-36-38). PM. K1. PM. K10 (12-12-12-14). PM. K1. PM. K1.

2nd row: Purl.

3rd row: Kfb. M1. SM. K1. SM. M1. K10 (12-12-12-14). M1. SM. K1. SM. M1. K32 (34-34-36-36-38). M1. SM. K1. SM. M1. K10 (12-12-12-14). M1. SM. K1. SM. M1. Kfb. 10 sts inc'd. **68** (74-74-76-76-82) sts.

4th row: Purl.

5th row: K1. (M1. Knit to next marker. M1. SM. K1. SM) 4 times. M1. Knit to last st. M1. K1. 10 sts inc'd. **78** (84-84-86-92) sts.

6th to 21st rows: Rep last 2 rows 8 times more. **158** (**164-164-166-166-172**) sts.

22nd row: Cast on **10** (**12-12-14-16**) sts (center front). Turn. Join in rnd.

Beg working in rnds: 1st rnd: K20. PM for beg of rnd. Knit to end. **168** (176-176-178-180-188) sts.

2nd rnd: (Knit to next marker. M1. SM. K1. SM. M1) 4 times. Knit to end. 8 sts inc'd. **176** (**184-184-186-188-196**) sts.

3rd rnd: Knit.

4th rnd: (Knit to next marker. M1. SM. K1. SM. M1) 4 times. Knit to end. 8 sts inc'd. **184** (**192-192-194-196-204**) sts.

Rep last 2 rnds 2 (4-3-7-10-5) times more, changing to longer circular needle when necessary to accommodate sts. 200 (224-216-250-276-244) sts.

Sizes XS/S, M, L, XL and 4/5XL only: 1st rnd: Knit.

2nd rnd: (Knit to next marker. M1. SM. K1. SM. Knit to next marker. SM. K1. SM. M1) twice. Knit to end. 4 sts inc'd. **204** (**228-220-254-248**) sts. **3rd rnd:** Knit.

4th rnd: (Knit to next marker. M1. SM. K1. SM. M1) 4 times. Knit to end. 8 sts inc'd. **212** (**236-228-262-256**) sts.

Rep last 4 rnds 4 (3-3-0-3) times more. 260 (272-264-262-292) sts.

Sizes M, L, XL, 2/3XL and 4/5XL only: 1st to 3rd rnds: (Knit to next marker. M1. SM. K1. SM. Knit to next marker. SM. K1. SM. M1) twice. Knit to end. 4 sts inc'd each rnd. (284-276-274-288-304) sts.

4th rnd: (Knit to next marker. M1. SM. K1. SM. M1) 4 times. Knit to end. 8 sts inc'd. (292-284-282-296-312) sts.

Rep last 4 rnds (0-1-3-4-5) time(s) more. (292-304-342-376-412) sts.

All sizes: Remove markers. **260** (**292-304-342-376-412**) sts.

Divide for Sleeves and Body: Next rnd: K16 (18-19-21-24-29). Slip next 48 (54-54-60-66-68) sts onto scrap yarn (Sleeve).

Cast on 4 (2-4-3-4-6) sts. K82 (92-98-111-122-138) (Back). Slip next 48 (54-54-60-66-68) sts onto scrap yarn (Sleeve). Cast on 4 (2-4-3-4-6) sts. K66 (74-79-90-98-109). 172 (188-204-228-252-288) sts for Body. PM at center of last cast on sts for beg of rnd. Knit even until Body measures 12" [30.5 cm].

Change to smaller and longer circular needle.

Next rnd: *(K1tbl) twice. P2. Rep from * around.

Rep last rnd Twisted ribbing for 2½" [6 cm]. Cast off loosely in pat.

SLEEVES

With larger double-pointed set of needles, beg at center of underarm, pick up and knit 2 (1-3-1-2-3) st(s). K48 (54-54-60-66-68) from scrap yarn. Pick up and knit 2 (1-3-1-2-3) st(s) across rem of underarm. Join in rnd. PM for beg of rnd. Divide sts over 3 needles. 52 (56-60-62-70-74) sts. Knit even in rnds 2" [5 cm].



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Shape sleeve: Dec 1 st each end of next rnd and following 12th (9th-9th-8th-6th-5th) rnds 5 (7-7-8-10-12) times more. 40 (40-44-48-48) sts. Cont even until Sleeve from dividing rnd measures 14" [35.5 cm].

Change to smaller double-pointed needles and work 2½" [6 cm] in Twisted ribbing as given for Body. Cast off loosely in pat.

COLLAR

With RS facing and smaller, shorter circular needle, pick up and knit **96** (104-104-108-116) sts evenly around neck edge. Join in rnd, PM on first st. **Turn**. RS becomes WS of Collar.

Work 8" [20.5 cm] in Twisted ribbing as given for Body. Cast off loosely in pat.
