SIZES

To fit bust measurement

XS/S 28-34" [71-86.5 cm]

M 36-38" [91.5-96.5 cm]

L 40-42" [101.5-106.5 cm]

XL 44-46" [112-117 cm]

2/3XL 48-54" [122-137 cm]

4/5XL 56-62" [142-157.5 cm]

Finished bust measurement

XS/S 36" [91.5 cm]

M 40" [101.5 cm]

L 44" [112 cm]

XL 48" [122 cm]

2/3XL 56" [142 cm]

4/5XL 64" [162.5 cm]

GAUGE

20 sts and 26 rows = 4" [10 cm]
in stocking st with larger needles.
Take time to check your gauge

INSTRUCTIONS

smallest size. If changes are
necessary for larger size(s) the
instructions will be written thus (.).*

MATERIALS

Caron® Cotton Angel Cakes™ (8.8 oz/250 g; 530 yds/485 m)

Sizes XS/S M L XL 2/3XL 4/5XL

Cream Whip (12004) 2 2 2 3 3 4 cakes

Sizes U.S. 6 [4 mm] and U.S. 7 [4.5 mm] circular knitting needles 29" [73.5 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Yarn needle. Stitch holders. Stitch marker.

FRONT AND BACK (make alike):

With smaller needle, cast on **90 (100-110-120-140-160)** sts. **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:
Knit 7 rows (garter st), noting first row is WS.

Change to larger needle and proceed in stocking st until work from beg measures **15 (15-16-16-17-17)" [38 (38-40.5-40.5-43-43) cm]**, ending on a purl row.

Shape armholes: Cast off **4 (5-6-7-7-8)** sts at beg of next **2 (2-2-2-4-4)** rows. **82 (90-98-106-112-128)** sts.

Sizes XL, 2/3XL and 4/5XL only:

1st row: (RS). K2. K2tog. Knit to last 4 sts. ssk. K2.

2nd row: P2. P2togtbl. Purl to last 4 sts. P2tog. P2.

Rep last 2 rows **(1-2-5)** time(s) more. **(98-100-104)** sts.

All Sizes: 1st row: K2. K2tog. Knit to last 4 sts. ssk. K2.

2nd row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows **1 (5-6-6-3-5)** time(s) more. **78 (78-84-84-92-92)** sts.

Cont even until armhole measures **6 (7-7-7-8)" [16.5 (18-18-19-19-20.5) cm]**, ending on a purl row.

Shape neck: 1st row: (RS).

K14 (14-16-16-19-19). ssk. K2.

Turn. Leave rem sts on a st holder. **2nd row:** P2. P2togtbl. Purl to end of row.

3rd row: Knit to last 4 sts. ssk. K2. Rep last 2 rows twice more. **11 (11-13-13-16-16)** sts.

Purl 1 row. Cast off knitwise.

With RS facing, slip next **42 (42-44-44-46-46)** sts onto a st holder. Join yarn to rem **18 (18-20-20-23-23)** sts and proceed as follows:

1st row: K2. K2tog. Knit to end of row.

2nd row: Purl to last 4 sts. P2tog. P2.

3rd row: K2. K2tog. Knit to end of row.

Rep last 2 rows twice more. **11 (11-13-13-16-16)** sts.

Purl 1 row. Cast off knitwise.

FINISHING

Sew right shoulder seam.

Neckband: With RS facing and smaller needle, pick up and knit 7 sts down left front neck edge. **K42 (42-44-44-46-46)** from Front st holder. Pick up and knit 7 sts up right front neck edge and 7 sts down right back neck edge. **K42 (42-44-44-46-46)** from Back st holder. Pick up and knit 7 sts up left back neck edge. **112 (112-116-116-120-120)** sts.

Knit 2 rows. Cast off knitwise (WS). Sew left shoulder and neckband seam.

Armbands: With RS facing and smaller needle, pick up and knit **76 (82-82-88-98-106)** sts evenly along armhole edge.

Knit 3 rows. Cast off knitwise (WS). Sew side seams.
