ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Begin(ning)

Cont = Continue(ity)

K = Knit

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together

P = Purl

SIZES

To fit chest measurement

XS/S 28-34" [71-86.5 cm]

M 36-38" [91.5-96.5 cm]

L 40-42" [101.5-106.5 cm]

XL 44-46" [112-117 cm]

2/3XL 48-54" [122-137 cm]

4/5XL 56-62" [142-157.5 cm]

Finished chest

XS/S 43" [109 cm]

M 46" [117 cm]

L 50" [127 cm]

XL 54" [137 cm]

2/3XL 58" [147.5 cm]

4/5XL 66" [167.5 cm]

GAUGE

18 stitches (sts) and 24 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for **XS/S**. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written **XS/S (M-L-XL-2/3XL-4/5XL)**. Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

Notes:

- Body is worked flat in 2 pieces (Front and Back) and seamed together (tog).
- Sleeves are picked up along Body and worked down to cuff.

Stripe Pattern (Pat) I

Notes:

- Break yarn at each color change.
- Final stripe of Pattern (Pat) will be fewer rows to work to length of Front and Back.

With A, work 32 rows.

With B, work 32 rows.

These 64 rows form Stripe Pat I.

FRONT and BACK (make alike)

Working in Stripe Pat I, with A, cast on **97** (**103-113-121-131-149**) sts.

1st row: [Right Side (RS)]. *Knit 1 (K1). Purl 1 (P1). Repeat (Rep) from * to last st. K1.

2nd row: *P1. K1. Rep from * to last st. P1.

Rep last 2 rows of (K1.P1) ribbing 5 times more, ending on a 2nd row (12 rows in total).

Beginning (beg) on a RS row and keeping continuity (cont) of Stripe Pat I, proceed in stocking st [knit RS rows, purl Wrong Side (WS) rows] until piece measures **20** (**20-21-22-23-24**)" [**51** (**51-53.5-56-58.5-61**) cm], ending on a purl row.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat I, proceed in Neck and Shoulder Ribbing as follows:

Work 12 rows in (K1. P1) ribbing. Cast off evenly in ribbing (take care to not cast off too tightly).

Place markers for shoulders **5¾** (**6½-7-8-9-11**)" [**14.5** (**16.5-18-20.5-23-28**) cm] in from side edges – approximately (approx) **10** (**10-11-11-11-11**)" [**25.5** (**25.5-28-28-28-28**) cm] left open for neck.

When Front and Back are complete, sew shoulder seams with MC to markers.

Place markers for Sleeve pick-up on side edges **8½** (**9-10-10¼-11½-12½**)" [**21.5** (**23-25.5-26-29-32**) cm] down from shoulder seams.

SLEEVES

Stripe Pat II

Notes:

- Break yarn at each color change.
- Final stripe of Pat may be fewer rows to work to length of Sleeve.

With A, work 10 rows.

With C, work 10 rows.

These 20 rows form Stripe Pat II.

With RS facing and A, pick up and knit **76** (**80-90-92-104-112**) sts evenly between markers on side edges of Front and Back.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat II, proceed in stocking st until Sleeve from shoulder measures **13¾** (**14½-14-14-14-13**)" [**35** (**37-35.5-35.5-35.5-33**) cm], ending on a purl row.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat II, proceed as follows:

Next row: [RS-Decrease row].

*K2. Knit next 2 stitches together (K2tog). Rep from * to end of row.

57 (**60-66-69-78-84**) sts.

Next row: Purl.

Next row: *K2tog. K1. Rep from * to end of row. **38** (**40-44-46-52-56**) sts.

Next row: Purl.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat II, proceed with Cuff as follows:

Cuff: 1st row: (RS). *K1. P1. Rep from * to end of row. Rep last row of (K1. P1) ribbing 11 times more, ending on a WS row (12 rows total).

Cast off in ribbing.

FINISHING

With matching yarn, sew side and sleeve seams.
