Size U.S. $8(5 \mathrm{~mm}$ ) Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ circular knitting needle 24 " [ 61 cm ] long or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ stitch markers. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ stitch holders. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ yarn needle.

## GAUGE

16 sts and 20 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] with larger needles in stocking st.

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for XS/S. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written XS/S (M-L-XL-2/3XL-4/5XL). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

## BODY

Work Body in rounds with longer circular needle from lower edge to armholes.

With smaller, longer circular needle and MC, cast on 168 (184-200-216-232-244) sts. Join in rnd being careful do not twist sts. PM for beg of rnd.
1st rnd: Purl.

## 2nd rnd: Knit.

Rep last 2 rnds for garter st twice more.

Change to larger, longer circular needle and knit 2 rnds.

Proceed in Chain Links Pat as follows:


Note: Do not break colors. Carry colors not in use loosely up side of work.
1st rnd: With A, knit.
2nd rnd: *P1. Sl1Pwyif. Rep from * around.

3rd rnd: P1. *P1. SI1Pwyif. Rep from * to last st. P1.
4th to 6th rnds: With MC, knit.
7th to 9th rnds: With $B$ as 1st to 3rd rnds.
10th to 12th rnds: With MC, knit. 13th to 15th rnds: With $C$ as 1 st to 3 rd rnds.
16th to 18th rnds: With MC, knit. Rep 1st to 18th rnds of Chain Links Pat once more. Break A, B and C.

Next rnd: With MC, K84 (92-100-108-116-122). PM. Knit to end of rnd.

Proceed in Eyelet Pat with MC as follows:

## 1st to 19th rnds: Knit

20th rnd: *K7 (11-7-11-6-9). (yo. ssk. K15) 4 (4-5-5-6-6) times. yo. ssk. K7 (11-6-10-6-9). Rep from * once more.

## 21st to 39th rnds: Knit.

40th rnd: *K15 (19-15-19-14-17). (yo. ssk. K15) 3 (3-4-4-5-5) times. yo. ssk. K16 (20-15-19-15-18). Rep from * once more.

Rep last 40 rnds for Eyelet Pat until work from beg measures 15 " [ 38 cm ] ending on an oddnumbered rnd. (Eyelet rnds when working in rows - after armhole divide - must happen on RS rows).

Front and Back will now be worked in rows (you may switch to straight knitting needles or keep working with circular knitting needle back and forth in rows).

Divide for Front and Back and proceed in rows:

## BACK

1st row: (RS). Keeping cont of Eyelet Pat, pat across 84 (92-100-108-116-122) sts for Back. Turn. Leave rem sts on a st holder.

Beg on a purl (WS) row, working back and forth in rows, cont in Eyelet Pat until Back from dividing rnd measures $81 / 4$ ( $8^{3 / 4}-93 / 4-10^{1 / 4}$ -103/4-113/4)" [21 (22-25-26-27.5$30) \mathrm{cm}$ ], ending on a purl (WS) row.

Shape back neck: 1st row: (RS). K24 (28-31-34-36-39). K2tog. Turn. Leave rem sts on a spare needle.
2nd row: P2tog. Purl to end of row. Cast off 24 (28-31-34-36-39) sts.

With RS facing slip next 32 (32-34-36-40-40) sts from spare needle onto a st holder. Join MC to rem sts. ssk. Knit to end of row.
Next row: Purl to last 2 sts. P2togtbl.
Cast off 24 (28-31-34-36-39) sts.

## FRONT

Slip sts from st holder onto larger needle.
With MC, cont in Eyelet Pat across 84 (92-100-108-116-122) sts back and forth across needle in rows, until Front from dividing rnd measures 14 rows less than Back, ending on a purl (WS) row.

Shape front neck: 1st row: (RS). K29 (33-36-39-41-44). K2tog. Turn. Leave rem sts on a spare needle.
2nd row: P2tog. Purl to end of row.
29 (33-36-39-41-44) sts.
3rd row: Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog. 28 (32-35-38-40-43) sts.
4th and 5th rows: As 2nd and 3rd rows. 26 (30-33-36-38-41) sts.

## 6th row: Purl.

7th row: Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog. 25 (29-32-35-37-40) sts.
Rep last 2 rows once more. 24 (28-31-34-36-39) sts.

Cont even in Eyelet Pat until Front measures same length as Back before shoulder, ending on a WS row. Cast off.

With RS facing slip next 22 (22-24-26-30-30) sts from spare needle onto a st holder. Join MC to rem sts. ssk. Knit to end of row.
2nd row: Purl to last 2 sts. P2togtbl. 29 (33-36-39-41-44) sts.
3rd row: ssk. Knit to end of row. 28 (32-35-38-40-43) sts.
4th and 5th rows: As 2nd and 3rd rows. 26 (30-33-36-38-41) sts.
6th row: Purl.
7th row: ssk. Knit to end of row. 25 (29-32-35-37-40) sts.
Rep last 2 rows once more. 24 (28-31-34-36-39) sts.

Cont even in Eyelet Pat until Front measures same length as Back before shoulder, ending on a WS row. Cast off.

Sew shoulder seams.

Work Sleeves with shorter circular needles in rounds joining onto Body and working down to cuff.

## SLEEVES

With shorter, larger circular needle and C, beg at side seam of Body, pick up and knit 69 (72-81-84-90-96) sts evenly around armhole edge. Join in rnd. PM for beg of rnd.

## Yarnspirations <br> spark your inspiration!

Proceed in Lace Mesh Pat (multiple of 3 sts) as follows:
1st rnd: K2. *yo. SI1P. K2. pss2o. Rep from * to last st. K1.
2nd rnd: Knit.
3rd rnd: K1. *yo. SI1P. K2. pss2o. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K2.

## 4th rnd: Knit.

Rep last 4 rows of Lace Mesh Pat until Sleeve measures $61 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ [16.5 cm].

Next rnd: With MC, K10 (11-12-13-13-14). K2tog. [K21 (22-24-26-27-28). K2tog] twice. Knit to end of rnd. 66 (69-78-81-87-93) sts.
Next 3 rnds: Knit.
Next rnd: With B, K9 (10-11-12-1213). K2tog. [K20 (21-23-25-26-27). K2tog] twice. Knit to end of rnd. 63 (66-75-78-84-90) sts.

With B, proceed in Lace Mesh Pat until Sleeve measures approx 15 " [ 38 cm ], ending on a 2nd or 4th rnd of pat. Break B.

Change to shorter, smaller circular needle.
Next rnd: With MC, K3 (3-4-4-5-5). K2tog. [K7 (7-8-9-10-10). K2tog] 7 times. Knit to end of rnd. 56 (59-68-71-77-83) sts.

Next rnd: Purl.
Next rnd: Knit.
Rep last 2 rnds twice more.
Cast off purlwise.

Rep for second Sleeve.
Work neck edging with shorter circular needle in rounds. For embroidery follow diagram for Diamond Eyelet Stitch.

Neck edging: With shorter, larger circular needle and MC, beg at left shoulder seam, pick up and knit 12 sts down left front neck edge. K22 (22-24-26-30-30) from front st holder. Pick up and knit 12 sts up right front neck edge. Pick up and knit 3 sts down right back neck edge. K32 (32-34-36-40-40) from back st holder. Pick up and knit 3 sts up left back neck edge. Join in rnd. PM for beg of rnd. Knit 2 rnds.
Next rnd: With A, knit.
Next rnd: *P1. Sl1Pwyif. Rep from * around.

Next rnd: P1. *P1. SI1Pwyif. Rep from * to last st. P1.

Next 3 rnds: With MC, knit.

Change to shorter, smaller circular needle.

## Next rnd: Purl.

## Next rnd: Knit

Rep last 2 rnds once more.
Cast off purlwise.
Using yarn needle and straight stitches, embroider Diamond Eyelet stitch around each eyelet on Front and Back as shown on diagram, changing colors randomly. Work partial embroidery at neck edge as shown in photo.
