



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

## ABBREVIATIONS

**Beg** = Begin(ing)  
**Cont** = Continue(ity)  
**Dec** = Decrease  
**Inc** = Increase  
**K** = Knit  
**K2tog** = Knit next 2 stitches together  
**P** = Purl  
**P2tog** = Purl next 2 stitches together  
**P2togtbl** = Purl next 2 stitches together through back loops

**Pat** = Pattern  
**Rem** = Remaining  
**Rep** = Repeat  
**RS** = Right side  
**Ssk** = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together.  
**St(s)** = Stitch(es)  
**WS** = Wrong side

## SIZES

### To fit bust measurement

**XS/S** 28-34" [71-86.5 cm]  
**M** 36-38" [91.5-96.5 cm]  
**L** 40-42" [101.5-106.5 cm]  
**XL** 44-46" [112-117 cm]  
**2/3XL** 48-54" [122-137 cm]  
**4/5XL** 56-62" [142-157.5 cm]

### Finished bust

**XS/S** 34" [86.5 cm]  
**M** 38" [96.5 cm]  
**L** 42" [106.5 cm]  
**XL** 46" [117 cm]  
**2/3XL** 54" [137 cm]  
**4/5XL** 60" [152.5 cm]

## MATERIALS

Caron® Cotton Funnel Cakes™ (8.8 oz/250 g; 425 yds/389 m)

Sizes	XS/S	M	L	XL	2/3XL	4/5XL	
<b>Contrast A</b>							
Lilac (43019)	1	1	1	1	2	2	cake(s)
<b>Contrast B</b>							
Golden Rays (43018)	1	1	1	1	2	2	cake(s)
<b>Contrast C</b>							
Rose Petal (43013)	1	1	1	2	2	3	cake(s)

Sizes U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) and U.S. 8 (5 mm) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch holders. Yarn needle.

## GAUGE

19 sts and 25 rows = 4" [10 cm] with larger needles in stocking st.

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus ( ). When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes.

### Stripe Pat I

With B – 1 row. With A – 4 rows.  
With B – 2 rows. With A – 3 rows.  
With B – 3 rows. With A – 2 rows.  
With B – 4 rows. With A – 1 row.  
These 20 rows form Stripe Pat I.

### Stripe Pat II

With C – 1 row. With B – 4 rows.  
With C – 2 rows. With B – 3 rows.  
With C – 3 rows. With B – 2 rows.  
With C – 4 rows. With B – 1 row.  
These 20 rows form Stripe Pat II.

### Body Pat

Work 20 rows of Stripe Pat I.  
With B, work in stocking st for 4½" [11.5 cm].  
Work 20 rows of Stripe Pat II.  
With C, work in stocking st to end.

### Front and Back (make alike)

With A and smaller needles, cast on **83 (93-104-114-133-147)** sts. Knit 3 rows, noting 1st row is WS and inc **3 (3-4-4-5-5)** sts evenly across last row. **86 (96-108-118-138-152)** sts.

Change to larger needles and proceed in stocking st until work from beg measures **3½ (3½-3½-3½-4-4)" [9 (9-9-9-10-10) cm]**, ending on a purl row.

Proceed in Body Pat (see left) until work from beg measures **6½ (6½-6½-6½-8½-8½)" [16.5 (16.5-16.5-16.5-21.5-21.5) cm]**, ending on a purl row.

**Shape sides:** Keeping cont of Body Pat, dec 1 st each end of row on next and every following **20th (20th-16th-16th-12th-12th) row 2 (2-3-3-4-4)** times more. **80 (90-100-110-128-142)** sts.

Cont even in Body Pat until work from beg measures **15 (15-15-15-18-18)" [38 (38-38-38-45.5-45.5) cm]**, ending on a purl row.

**Shape armholes:** Cast off **4 (5-5-8-10-14)** sts beg next 2 rows. **72 (80-90-94-108-114)** sts.

**1st row:** (RS). K1. K2tog. Knit to last 3 sts. ssk. K1.

**2nd row:** P1. P2togtbl. Purl to last 3 sts. P2tog. P1.

Rep last 2 rows **2 (3-4-5-5-5)** times more. **60 (64-70-70-84-90)** sts.

**Next row:** (RS). K1. K2tog. Knit to last 3 sts. ssk. K1.

**Next row:** Purl.  
Rep last 2 rows **4 (3-4-3-7-7)** times more. **50 (56-60-62-68-74)** sts.

Work even in Body Pat until armhole measures **3½ (3½-4-4-5-5½)" [9 (9-10-10-12.5-14) cm]**, ending on a purl row.

**Shape neck: 1st row:** (RS). K15 (**15-17-17-20-20**). K2tog. K1.  
**Turn.** Leave rem sts on a st holder.  
**2nd row:** P1. P2tog. Purl to end of row.

**3rd row:** Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1.

**4th and 5th rows:** As 2nd and 3rd rows.

**6th row:** Purl.  
Rep last 2 rows 3 times more. **10 (10-12-12-15-15)** sts rem.

Work even until armhole measures **7 (7-7½-7½-8½-9)" [18 (18-19-19-21.5-23) cm]**, ending on a purl row. Cast off.

With RS facing, slip next **14 (20-20-22-22-28)** sts onto a st holder. Join C to rem sts and proceed as follows:

**1st row:** (RS). K1. ssk. Knit to end of row.

**2nd row:** Purl to last 3 sts. P2togtbl. P1.

**3rd and 4th rows:** As 1st and 2nd rows.

**5th row:** As 1st row.

**6th row:** Purl.  
Rep last 2 rows 3 times more. **10 (10-12-12-15-15)** sts rem.

Work even until armhole measures **7 (7-7½-7½-8½-9)" [18 (18-19-19-21.5-23) cm]**, ending on a purl row. Cast off.

## FINISHING

Pin all pieces to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth leaving cloth to dry. Sew right shoulder seam.

**Neck Edging:** With RS facing, C and smaller needles, pick up and knit 21 sts down left front neck edge. K14 (20-20-22-22-28) from front st holder, dec 1 st at center. Pick up and knit 42 sts up right front and down right back neck edge. K14 (20-20-22-22-28) from back st holder, dec 1 st at center. Pick up and knit 21 sts up left back neck edge. 110 (122-122-126-126-138) sts.

Knit 2 rows.

Cast off knitwise (WS).

Sew left shoulder seam.

**Armhole Edging:** With RS facing, C and smaller needles, pick up and knit 74 (76-80-86-96-106) sts evenly along armhole edge.

Knit 2 rows.

Cast off knitwise (WS).

Sew side seams.
