



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: **BEGINNER**

ABBREVIATIONS

SIZES

To fit chest measurement

XS/S 28-34" [71-86.5 cm]
M 36-38" [91.5-96.5 cm]
L 40-42" [101.5-106.5 cm]
XL 44-46" [112-117 cm]
2/3XL 48-54" [122-137 cm]
4/5XL 56-62" [142-157.5 cm]

Finished chest measurement

XS/S 37½" [95 cm]
M 41½" [105.5 cm]
L 45½" [115.5 cm]
XL 49½" [125.5 cm]
2/3XL 54½" [138.5 cm]
4/5XL 62½" [159 cm]

GAUGE

18 stitches (sts) and 24 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st with larger needles.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (.). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

FRONT and BACK (make alike):

Beginning (beg) at lower edge with smaller needle, cast on **86** (95-104-113-125-143) sts (multiple of 3 sts + 2).
 Knit every row (garter st), noting first row is Wrong Side (WS), until work from beg measures approximately (approx) 1½" [4 cm], ending on a WS row.

MATERIALS

Caron® Cotton Funnel Cakes™ (8.8 oz/250 g; 530 yds/485 m)

Sizes	XS/S	M	L	XL	2/3XL	4/5XL	
Thistle (43007)	2	2	3	3	3	4	balls

Sizes U.S. 6 (4 mm) and U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge**. Tapestry needle. Stitch marker.

BODY

Change to larger needles and proceed in Lace Pat as follows:

1st row: Right Side (RS). Knit 1 (K1). *K1. Yarn over (yo). Knit next 2 stitches together (K2tog). Repeat (Rep) from * to last st. K1.

2nd row: Purl 1 (P1). *P1. yo. Purl next 2 stitches together (P2tog). Rep from * to last st. P1.

3rd row: K1. *K1. yo. K2tog. Rep from * to last st. K1.

4th row: P1. *P1. yo. P2tog. Rep from * to last st. P1.

Rep last 2 rows for Lace Pat until work from beg measures approx 14" [35.5 cm], ending on a WS row.

Shape sleeves

1st row: (RS). Cast on 11 sts. K3. *K1. yo. K2tog. Rep from * to last st. K1. **97** (106-115-124-136-154) sts.

2nd row: Cast on 11 sts. K3. *P1. yo. P2tog. Rep from * to last 3 sts. K3. **108** (117-126-135-147-165) sts. Place marker (PM) at end of row.

3rd row: K3. *K1. yo. K2tog. Rep from * to last 3 sts. K3.

4th row: K3. *P1. yo. P2tog. Rep from * to last 3 sts. K3.

Rep last 2 rows for pattern (pat) until work from marked row measures approx **8** (**8½-9-9½-10-10½**)" [**20.5** (**21.5-23-24-25.5-26.5**) cm], ending on a WS row.

Shape shoulders

Next 8 rows: Cast off **8** (**9-10-11-13-15**) sts. Knit to end of row. **44** (**45-46-47-43-45**) sts remain. Cast off.

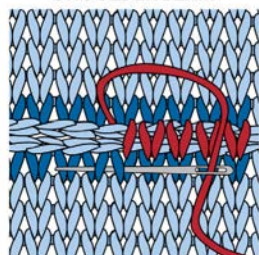
FINISHING

Pin all pieces to schematic measurements. Cover with a damp cloth, leaving cloth to dry.

Sew shoulder seams as shown in diagram, leaving center **9¾** (**10-10¼-10½-9½-10**)" [**25** (**25.5-26-26.5-24-25.5**) cm] open for Neck.

Sew Front and Back side seams using vertical mattress st, as shown in diagram.
