### **Finished chest**

XS/S	36½" [93 cm]
M	45" [114.5 cm]
L	51" [129.5 cm]
XL	56½" [143.5 cm]
2/3XL	62" [157.5 cm]
4/5XL	68" [172.5 cm]

### **GAUGES**

18 sts and 24 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking stitch.

14 sts and 20 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Ladder St Pattern, after stitches have been dropped.

## **INSTRUCTIONS**

The instructions are written for **XS/S**. If changes are necessary for larger size(s) the instructions will be written **XS/S** (M-L-XL-2/3XL-4/5XL). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.



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**Note:** Work will increase in width once Ladder stitches are dropped during cast-off.

**FRONT & BACK** (make 2 pieces alike)

Cast on **78** (96-108-120-132-144) sts.

Work 6 rows garter st (knit every row), noting 1st row is RS.

# Set up for pat as follows:

**1st row:** (Dec row - RS). \*K1. K2tog. Rep from \* to end of row. **52** (64-72-80-88-96) sts.

2nd row: P4. \*yo. P4. Rep from \* to end of row. 64 (79-89-99-109-119) sts. Place markers at each end of last row. When casting off, sts will be dropped down to this row.

**3rd row:** \*K4. P1. Rep from \* to last 4 sts. K4.

4th row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows for pat until piece measures **16** (**16-17-17-18-19**)" [**39.5** (**39.5-44.5-44.5-45.5-48**) cm], ending on a WS row.

Shape neck: Left side: 1st row: (RS). Pat across 19 (24-29-34-34-39) sts. Turn. Leave rem sts unworked.

2nd row: Purl.

**3rd row:** Pat to last 2 sts. K2tog.

Turn.

4th row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows once more. 17 (22-

27-32-37) sts

Work a further 10 rows in pat.

Cast off knitwise as follows: \*Cast off 3 sts. Drop purl st from left-hand needle, allowing it to unravel down to row with markers at each end. Slip st on right-hand needle onto left-hand needle. K2tog. Rep from \* to last st. Cast off last st.

Fasten off.

**Shape Right Shoulder: Cast off** front neck: 1st row: (RS). Join yarn by picking up a st in side of last st of first row of neck shaping. Drop purl st. Slip st on right-hand needle onto left-hand needle. K2tog. \*Cast off next 3 sts to next purl st. Drop purl st from left-hand needle, allowing it to unravel down to row with markers at each end. Make 2 'chain sts' on right-hand needle as follows: (insert tip of left needle through front of st on right-hand needle. Yrn and draw yarn through st onto right-hand needle) twice.\*\* Slip st on right-hand needle onto

left-hand needle. K2tog. Rep from \* 3 (4-4-4-6-6) times, then from \* to \*\* once. Slip st on right-hand needle onto left-hand needle. K2tog. Pat to end of row. 19 (24-29-34-34-39) sts.

2nd row: Purl

3rd row: ssk. Pat to end of row.

4th row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows once more. 17 (22-27-32-32) sts.

Work a further 10 rows in pat.

Cast off knitwise as follows: Cast off 1 st. \*Drop purl st from left-hand needle, allowing it to unravel down to row with markers at each end. Slip st on right-hand needle onto left-hand needle. K2tog. Cast off 3 sts. Rep from \* to end of row. Fasten off.

#### **FINISHING**

Pin all pieces to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth leaving cloth to dry.

Sew right shoulder seam.

Neck edging: With RS facing, pick up and knit 12 sts down right front neck edge. Pick up and knit 26 (31-31-31-41-41) sts along front neck cast-off edge. Pick up and knit 12 sts up right front neck edge. Pick up and knit 25 (30-30-30-40-40) sts along back neck edge. 75 (85-85-85-105-105) sts.

**Next row:** (WS). Knit. Cast off knitwise (RS).

Sew left shoulder and neck edging seam.

Place markers on side edges of Front and Back 8½ (8½-9½-9½-9½-10-11)" [21.5 (21.5-24-24-25.5-28) cm] down from shoulders for armhole openings.

Sew side seams to markers.
