## GAUGE

18 sts and 24 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in stocking st with larger needles.

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

## C月10 CHILD'S KNIT CREW NECK PULLOVER

## BACK

**With smaller needles cast on 58 (62-66-70-74) sts.
1st row: (RS). *K2. P2. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K2.
2nd row: *P2. K2. Rep from * to last 2 sts. P2.

Rep last 2 rows (K2. P2) ribbing for 2 (2-2-2½-2½)" [5 (5-5-6-6) cm], ending on a 2 nd row and inc 1 (1-3-3-3) st(s) evenly across last row. 59 (63-69-73-77) sts.

Change to larger needles and proceed in stocking st until work from beg measures 9 (10-11-11 $1 / 2-12 \frac{112}{2}$ )" [23 (25.5-28-29-32) cm], ending on a purl row.

Shape raglans: Cast off 2 (2-2-$3-3$ ) sts beg next 2 rows. 55 (59-65-67-71) sts.

Sizes 2, 4, 6 and 8 only: Next row: (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.
Next row: P2. P2tog. Purl to last 4 sts. P2togtbl. P2.

All sizes: 1st row: (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.
2nd row: Purl.**
Rep last 2 rows 14 (15-17-18-21) times more. Leave rem 21 (23-25-25-27) sts on a st holder.

## FRONT

Work from ${ }^{* *}$ to ${ }^{* *}$ as given for Back.
Rep last 2 rows 7 (8-9-10-13) times more. 35 (37-41-43-43) sts.

Shape neck: 1st row: (RS). K2. ssk. K8 (8-10-10-12) (neck edge). Turn. 2nd row: Purl.
3rd row: K2. ssk. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog.
Rep last 2 rows 2 (2-3-3-4) times more. 5 sts rem.
Next row: P5.
Next row: K1. ssk. K2tog.
Next row: P3.
Next row: K1. ssk.
Next row: P2.
Next row: ssk. Fasten off.

With RS facing, slip next 11 (13-13-15-11) sts onto a st holder.

1st row: (RS). Rejoin yarn to rem sts. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2. 2nd row: Purl.
3rd row: ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.
Rep last 2 rows 2 (2-3-3-4) times more. 5 sts rem.
Next row: P5.
Next row: ssk. K2tog. K1.
Next row: P3.
Next row: K2tog. K1.
Next row: P2.
Next row: K2tog. Fasten off.

## SLEEVES

With smaller needles, cast on 34 (34-38-38-42) sts.
Work 2 (2-2-2½-2½)" [5 (5-5-$6-6) \mathrm{cm}$ ] in (K2. P2) ribbing as given for Back, ending on a 2 nd row and inc 3 (3-3-3-1) st(s) evenly across last row. 37 (37-41-41-43) sts.

Change to larger needles and work 6 rows in stocking st.
Inc 1 st each end of next row and following 6th (4th-4th-4th-4th) rows until there are 45 (43-47-55-55) sts.

Sizes 4, 6, 8 and 10 only: Inc 1 st each end of following 6th rows until there are (49-55-59-63) sts.

All sizes: Cont even until work from beg measures 71/2 ( $9^{1 / 2}$ $101 / 2-111 / 2-12 \frac{112}{2}$ )" [19 (24-26.5-29-32) cm], ending on a purl row.

Shape raglans: Cast off 2 (2-2-$3-3$ ) sts beg next 2 rows. 41 (45-51-53-57) sts.
1st row: (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.
2nd row: P2. P2tog. Purl to last 4 sts. P2togtbl. P2.
3rd row: As 1st row.

## 4th row: Purl.

Rep last 4 rows 0 (1-2-1-1) time(s) more. 35 (33-33-41-45) sts.

1st row: (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.
2nd row: Purl.
Rep last 2 rows 13 (12-12-15-17) times more. Leave rem 7 (7-7-9-9) sts on a st holder.

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## FINISHING

Sew raglan seams leaving left back raglan seam open.

Neckband: With RS facing and smaller needles, K7 (7-7-9-9) from Left Sleeve st holder, dec 1 st at center. Pick up and knit 11 (11-12-12-14) sts down Left Front neck edge. K11 (13-13-15-11) from Front st holder. Pick up and knit 11 (11-12-12-14) sts up Right Front neck edge. K7 (7-7-9-9) from Right Sleeve st holder, dec 1 st at center. K21 (23-25-25-27) from Back st holder, dec 0 (0-0-2-0) sts evenly across. 66 (70-74-78-82) sts.

Beg on a 2nd row, work 7 rows in (K2. P2) ribbing as given for Back. Cast off loosely in ribbing. Sew left back raglan and neckband seam. Sew side and sleeve seams.
