## Finished chest

P2togtbl = Purl next 2 stitches together through back loops
Rem = Remaining
Rep $=$ Repeat
RS $=$ Right side
Ssk = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together
St(s) = Stitch(es)
WS = Wrong side

## GAUGE

18 sts and 24 rows $=4$ " 10 cm ] in stocking st with larger needles.

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus ( ). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

## BACK

**With smaller needles cast on 58 (62-66-70-74) sts.
1st row: (RS). *K2. P2. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K2.
2nd row: *P2. K2. Rep from * to last 2 sts. P2.
Rep last 2 rows (K2. P2) ribbing for 2 (2-2-2½-2½)" [5 (5-5-6-6) cm], ending on a 2 nd row and inc 1 (1-3-3-3) st(s) evenly across last row. 59 (63-69-73-77) sts.
Change to larger needles and proceed in stocking st until work from beg measures 9 (10-11-111/212½)" [23 (25.5-28-30-32.5) cm], ending on a purl row.

Shape raglans: Cast off 2 (2-2-2-3) sts beg next 2 rows. 55 (59-65-6971) sts.

Sizes 2, 4, 6 and 8 only: Next row: (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.
Next row: P2. P2tog. Purl to last 4 sts. P2togtbl. P2. 51 (55-61-65) sts.

All sizes: 1st row: (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.
2nd row: Purl.**
Rep last 2 rows 14 (15-17-19-21) times more. Leave rem 21 (23-25-25-27) sts on a st holder.

## FRONT

Work from ** to ** as given for Back. 49 (53-59-63-69) sts rem.

Shape neck: 1st row: (RS). K2. ssk. K18 (20-23-25-28). K2tog (neck edge). Turn. Leave rem sts on a spare needle.
2nd row: Purl.
3rd row: K2. ssk. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog.
4th row: Purl.
Rep last 2 rows 5 (6-6-4-4) times more. 10 (10-13-19-22) sts rem.

1st row: K2. ssk. Knit to end of row.
2nd row: Purl.
3rd row: K2. ssk. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog.
4th row: Purl.
Rep last 4 rows 1 (1-2-4-5) time(s) more. 4 sts rem.
Next row: K1. ssk. K1.
Next row: P3.
Next row: K1.ssk.
Next row: P2.
Next row: ssk. Fasten off.
With RS facing, slip next st
(center st) onto safety pin.
Join yarn to rem sts. ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.

## Next row: Purl.

Next row: ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.

## Next row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows 5 (6-6-4-4) times more. 10 (10-13-19-22) sts rem.

1st row: Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2. 2nd row: Purl.
3rd row: ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.
4th row: Purl.
Rep last 4 rows 1 (1-2-4-5) time(s) more. 4 sts rem.
Next row: K1. K2tog. K1.
Next row: P3.
Next row: K2tog. K1.
Next row: P2.
Next row: K2tog. Fasten off.

## SLEEVES

With smaller needles, cast on 34 (34-38-38-42) sts.
Work 2 (2-2-2½-2½)" [5 (5-5-66) cm ] in (K2. P2) ribbing as given for Back, ending on a 2 nd row and inc 3 (3-3-3-1) st(s) evenly across last row. 37 (37-41-41-43) sts.
Change to larger needles and work 6 rows in stocking st.
Inc 1 st each end of next row and following 6th (4th-4th-4th-4th) rows until there are 45 (43-47-5555) sts.

Sizes 4, 6, 8 and 10 only: Inc 1 st each end of following 6th rows until there are (49-55-57-63) sts.

All sizes: Cont even until work from beg measures $71 / 2(91 / 2-101 / 2$ $111 / 2-121 / 2)^{\text {) " }}$ [19 (24-26.5-29-32) cm ], ending on a purl row.

Shape raglans: Cast off 2 (2-2-2-3) sts beg next 2 rows. 41 (45-51-5357) sts.

1st row: (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.
2nd row: P2. P2tog. Purl to last 4 sts. P2togtbl. P2.
3rd row: As 1st row.
4th row: Purl.
Rep last 4 rows 0 (1-2-0-0) time(s) more. 35 (33-33-47-51) sts.

1st row: (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.

## 2nd row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows 13 (12-12-18-20) times more. Leave rem 7 (7-7-9-9) sts on a st holder.

## FINISHING

Sew raglan seams leaving left back raglan seam open.

V-neckband: With RS facing and smaller needles, K7 (7-7-9-9) from Left Sleeve st holder. Pick up and knit 23 (23-27-29-33) sts down Left Front neck edge. K1 from safety pin (place marker for center st). Pick up and knit 22 (24-26-28-34) sts up Right Front neck edge. K7 (7-7-99) from Right Sleeve st holder. K21 (23-25-25-27) from Back neck st holder. 81 (85-93-101-113) sts.

1st row: (WS). *P2. K2. Rep from * 11 (12-13-14-16) times more. P2tog. P1 (center st). P2tog. **K2. P2. Rep from ${ }^{* *}$ to end of row.

2nd row: *K2. P2. Rep from * to 3 sts before center st. P1. P2tog. K1 (center st). P2tog. Rib to end of row. 3rd row: *P2. K2. Rep from * to 2 sts before center st. K2tog. P1 (center st). K2tog. Rib to end of row.

4th row: *K2. P2. Rep from * to 3 sts before center st. K1. P2tog. K1 (center st). P2tog. Rib to end of row. 5th row: As 3rd row.
Rep last 4 rows once more. Cast off in ribbing, dec as before.
Sew left back raglan and neckband seam.
Sew side and sleeve seams.
