Caron ${ }^{\oplus}$ Big Donut ${ }^{\text {Tm }} \mathbf{O}^{\mathbf{\prime}} \mathbf{G o}^{\text {TM }}$ ( $9.9 \mathrm{oz} / 280 \mathrm{~g} ; 502 \mathrm{yds} / 459 \mathrm{~m}$ ) Boston Cream (29011)

1 O'Go


Note: 1 O'Go makes 2 Hats.
Size U.S. 3 ( 3.25 mm ) circular knitting needle 16 " ( 40.5 cm ) long. Set of 4 size U.S. 3 (3.25) double-pointed knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge. Stitch marker. Optional: Size U.S. 6 ( 4 mm ) circular knitting needle 16 " ( 40.5 cm ) long for cast on only.

## (c) MEDIUM KNIT I SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

## ABBREVIATIONS

Alt = Alternating

## Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning
BrDecL = (Worked over 3 stitches).
Slip next stitch knit-wise with yarn at back of work. Brk2tog through all strands. Pass both strands of slipped stitch over. 2 stitches decreased. (See photos on page 3)
BrDecR $=$ (Worked over 3 stitches) Slip next stitch knit-wise with yarn at back of work. Knit next stitch. Pass slipped stitch over just knit stitch and move stitch to left-hand needle. Pass second stitch on lefthand needle over first stitch. Move stitch to right hand needle. 2 stitches decreased. (See photos on page 4) BrK1 = Knit next stitch together with accompanying yarn over (see photos on page 5)

BrK2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together, including accompanying yarn over
BrP1 = Purl next stitch together with accompanying yarn over (see photos on page 5)
Dec $=$ Decrease
Pat = Pattern
Rem = Remaining
Rep $=$ Repeat
Rnd(s) $=$ Round(s)
Sl1yo = Slip next stitch purl-wise with yarn in front of work, bringing yarn over needle (and over slipped st) to back of work. Yarn is in place to work a knit stitch. If SI1yo precedes a purl stitch, bring yarn under needle to front of work to maintain yo before working purl stitch. (See photos on page 5)
St(s) = Stitch(es)
Yo = Yarn over

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## SIZE

One size to fit Adult.

## GAUGE

16 sts and 40 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in Brioche St Pat.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Notes:

- To begin working with O'Go, locate the end of the yarn.
- Carefully cut plastic tie where ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull to remove tie
- The wrap (yarn over) created by Sl1yo does not count as a separate stitch and should be treated as 1 stitch along with slipped stitch it accompanies.
- End each "BrP" rnd with yarn at back of work.
- End each "BrK" rnd with yarn at front of work.
- Color placement will vary due to self-striping effect of yarn. To create a 2 -color hat as pictured, cast on at the very start of a color change in yarn.

With circular needle, cast on 72 sts loosely. Join for working in rnd, placing marker on first stitch.

Optional: Use larger circular needle for cast on only.

Change to smaller circular needle and proceed as follows:
1st rnd (set up rnd): *K1. Sl1yo. Rep from * around.
2nd rnd: *SI1yo. BrP1. Rep from * around.
3rd rnd: *BrK1. Sl1yo. Rep from * around.
Rep last 2 rnds until Hat measures $101 / 22^{\prime \prime}[26.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ], ending on a 2 nd rnd.

Dec for crown as follows, switching to double-pointed needles as necessary:
1st rnd: *BrDecR. (SI1yo. BrK1) 5 times. Sl1yo. BrDecL. Sl1yo. Rep from * around. 56 sts.
2nd and alt rnds: *Sl1yo. BrP1. Rep from * around.
3rd, 5th and 7th rnds: *BrK1. Sl1yo. Rep from * around.
9th rnd: *BrDecR. (SI1yo. BrK1) 3 times. Sl1yo. BrDecL. SI1yo. Rep from * around. 40 sts.

11th, 13th and 15th rnds: *BrK1. Sl1yo. Rep from * around.
17th rnd: *BrDecR. SI1yo. BrK1.
Sl1yo. BrDecL. Sl1yo. Rep from * around. 24 sts.
19th rnd: *BrK1. Sl1yo. Rep from * around.

21st rnd: *BrDecR. Sl1yo. BrDecL. Sl1yo. Rep from * around. 12 sts.
Break yarn leaving a long end. Draw end tightly through rem sts and fasten securely


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## C8O1 $1^{\circ}$ KNIT BASIC BRIOCHE BEANIE

## BRIOCHE LEFT DECREASE

BrDecL $=$ Worked over 3 stitches
( $\mathrm{A}, \mathrm{B}, \mathrm{C}$ ).


1) Slip next stitch (A) knit-wise with yarn at back of work (SI1yo).

2) BrK2tog (B,C) through all strands.

3) Pass both strands of slipped stitch (A) over.

4) 2 stitches decreased.


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## CAROO кnit bastc brioche beanie

## BRIOCHE RIGHT DECREASE

$\underline{\operatorname{BrDecR}}=$ Worked over 3 stitches
(A, B, C).


4b) ...


1) Slip next stitch (A) knit-wise with yarn at back of work (SI1yo).

2) ... and move stitch to left-hand needle.

3) Knit next stitch (B).

4) Pass second stitch on left-hand needle (C) over first stitch (B).


4a) Pass slipped stitch (A) over stitch just knit (B)...

7) Move stitch to right-hand needle. 2 stitches decreased.


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## C8O1 $1^{\circ}$ KNIT BASIC BRIOCHE BEANIE

Sl1yo = Slip next stitch purl-wise with yarn in front of work, bringing yarn over needle (and over slipped stitch) to back of work. Yarn is in place to work a BrK1 stitch. If SI1yo precedes a BrP1 stitch, bring yarn under needle to front of work to maintain yo before working BrP1 stitch.


BrK1 = Knit next stitch together with accompanying yarn over.


BrP1 = Purl next stitch together with accompanying yarn over.
