



 KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx =

Approximately

Beg = Begin(ning)

Cont = Continue(ity)

K = Knit

K1below = Knit into next stitch 1 row below, at same time, slipping off stitch above

Pat = Pattern

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side



MEASUREMENTS

Approx 9½" [24 cm] wide x 75" [190.5 cm] long, excluding fringe

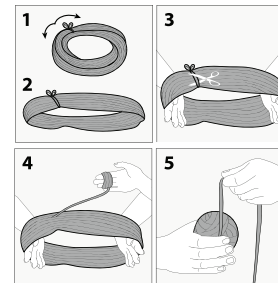
GAUGE

13 sts and 30 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Beehive Pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- Before working with Caron® x Pantone™ multi-shade yarn braid, separate each color link and wind into 5 separate balls.



- Each color link will be referenced by its Pantone color # (see label).
- Designate each different shade of the 5 separate yarn balls as Contrast A, B, C, etc as noted on page 2 (or as desired).
- Due to finite amount of yarn in each shade, pattern gauge must be matched to ensure successful results.

MATERIALS

Caron® x Pantone™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 127 yds/116 m)

Olive Oil (01007) **3 braids**

Moody Pumpkins (01021) **4 braids**

Size U.S. 10 (6 mm) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

Stripe Pat

With B, work 4 rows.

With A, work 4 rows.

With C, work 4 rows.

With F, work 4 rows.

With G, work 8 rows.

With H, work 4 rows.

With D, work 4 rows.

With H, work 8 rows.

With I, work 4 rows.

With H, work 4 rows.

With D, work 4 rows.

With H, work 4 rows.

With I, work 4 rows.

With J, work 8 rows.

With E, work 4 rows.

With J, work 4 rows.

With C, work 4 rows.

With A, work 4 rows.

These 80 rows form Stripe Pat.

With A, cast on 33 sts.

1st row: (WS). Knit.

2nd row: K2. *K1below. K1. Rep from * to last st. K1.

3rd row: Knit.

4th row: K3. *K1below. K1. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K2.

Last 4 rows form Beehive Pat.

Cont in Beehive Pat, beg with B and WS facing, proceed in Stripe Pat until 6 repeats of Stripe Pat are complete.

With B, work 4 rows in pat.

With A, work 4 rows in pat.

With A, cast off knitwise (WS).

FRINGE

Cut 18" [45.5 cm] lengths of C, D, G, F, I and J.

Taking 6 strands tog, knot each shade tog into 12 fringes for each end of Scarf in 2 repeats of this order: I, D, J, C, G and F.

Trim fringe evenly.
