 KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 52" x 65" [132 x 165 cm].

GAUGE

16 sts and 24 rows = 4" [10 cm] in pattern.

INSTRUCTIONS

Stripe Pat

With A: 15 rows.

With B: 30 rows.

With C: 30 rows.

With A: 15 rows.

These 90 rows form Stripe Pat.

With A, cast on 198 sts. **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:
Knit 14 rows (garter st) noting 1st row is RS and inc 10 sts evenly across last row. 208 sts.

Beg Stripe Pat, proceed as follows:

1st row: (RS). K4. *K1. P1. Rep from * to last 4 sts. K4.

2nd row: K4. *P1. K1. Rep from * to last 4 sts. K4.

These 2 rows form pat.

Cont in pat as established until 90 rows of Stripe Pat have been completed 4 times.

Next row: (RS). With A, knit, dec 10 sts evenly across. 198 sts.

With A, knit 13 rows.

Cast off.

MATERIALS

Caron® One Pound® (16 oz/454 g; 812 yds/742 m)

Contrast A Off White (10514) **1 ball**

Contrast B Persimmon (10610) **1 ball**

Contrast C Lavender Blue (10613) **1 ball**

Size U.S. 8 (5 mm) circular knitting needle 36" [91.5 cm] long
or size needed to obtain gauge.
