Size U.S. 15 ( 10 mm ) circular knitting needle 40" [ 101.5 cm ] long or size needed to obtain gauge. Stitch marker.

## ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximate (ly) $\quad \mathbf{P}=$ Purl
Cont $=$ Continue(ity) $\quad$ Rep $=$ Repeat(ing)
K = Knit

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 50½ x 60½" [128.5 x 153.5 cm ].

## GAUGE

8 sts and 12 rows $=4$ " [10 cm in pat holding 3 strands of yarn tog.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Stripe Pat

26 rows with 3 strands of A.
26 rows with 2 strands of A and 1 strand of B.
26 rows with 1 strand of $A$ and 2 strands of B.
26 rows with 3 strands of $B$.
26 rows with 2 strands of $B$ and 1 strand of C.
26 rows with 1 strand of $B$ and 2 strands of C .
26 rows with 3 strands of C. These 182 rows form Stripe Pat.

Tog = Together
Note: Wind each ball of yarn into 3 equal size balls for ease of working.

With 3 strands of A held tog, cast on 101 sts. Do not join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:
1st row: *P2. K2. Rep from * to last st. P1.
2nd row: *K2. P2. Rep from * to last st. K1.
Rep last 2 rows for Ridge St Pat. First 2 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.
Cont in Ridge St and Stripe Pat until 182 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.
With 3 strands of $C$, cast off in pat.
