CARON

**CATCH SOME WAVES BLANKET** | KNIT



### **MATERIALS**

**Caron® One Pound™** (16 oz/453.6 g; 812 yds/742 m) 1 ball **Main Color (MC)** Cream (10589) or Grey (10505) **Contrast A** Agua (10622) or Ocean (10611) 1 ball **Contrast B** Lace (10585) or Azure (10523) 1 ball Contrast C Ocean (10611) or Off White (10514) 1 ball

Size U.S. 9 (5.5 mm) circular knitting needle 36" [90 cm] long or size needed to obtain gauge.

#### ABBREVIATIONS:

**Approx** = Approximately **Beg** = Beginning K = Knit**K2tog** = Knit next 2

**Kfb** = Increase 1 stitch by knitting into front and back of next stitch **Pat** = Pattern **Rep** = Repeat

**RS** = Right side **Ssk** = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together. **St(s)** = Stitch(es) **WS** = Wrong side

KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

#### **MEASUREMENTS**

Approx 42" x 55" [106.5 x 140 cm].

## **GAUGE**

15 sts and 19 rows = 4'' [10 cm] in stocking st.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

With A, cast on 166 sts. Do not join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:

Knit 5 rows (garter st), noting first row is Cast off knitwise (WS). WS.

1st row: (RS). With MC, K3. Kfb. K5. ssk. K2tog. K5. \*(Kfb) twice. K5. ssk. K2tog. K5. Rep from \* to last 4 sts. Kfb. K3.

2nd row: K3. Purl to last 3 sts. K3. These 2 rows form Chevron Pat.

With MC, work a further 6 rows in pat. \*\*With A, work 2 rows in pat. With B, work 4 rows in pat. With C, work 2 rows in pat. With B, work 2 rows in pat. With MC, work 2 rows in pat. With A, work 2 rows in pat. With MC, work 8 rows in pat.\*\* Rep from \*\* to \*\* until work from beg measures approx 54" [137 cm], ending with 8 rows of MC in pat.

With A, knit 5 rows (garter st).
