MATERIALS

Caron® One Pound™ (16 oz/453.6 g; 812 yds/742 m) **Main Color (MC)** Cream (10589)

Contrast A Country Rose (10535)

Contrast B Dark Pink (10621)

Contrast C Scarlet (10516)

2 balls

1 ball

1 ball

Size U.S. 8 (5 mm) knitting needles. Size U.S. 8 (5 mm) circular knitting needle 40" [101.5 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch marker.

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximate(ly)

Beg = Begin(ning)

Inc = Increase(ing)

K = Knit

K2(3)tog = Knit next 2(3) stitches

together

Kfb = Increase 1 stitch by knitting into front and back of next stitch.

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tog = Together

WS = Wrong side

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 52 x 62" [132 x 157.5 cm].

GAUGE

16 sts and 28 rows = 4" [10 cm] in garter st.

Motif = Approx 10" [25.5 cm] square.

INSTRUCTIONS

Motif

Make 10 with A as Color 2. Make 10 with B as Color 2. Make 10 with C as Color 2.

Note: It may be helpful to place a removable st marker on RS of work to keep track of RS and WS.

With MC and pair of needles, cast on 3 sts.

1st row: (RS). Knit.

2nd row: Kfb. Knit to end of row. Rep last row, inc 1 st at beg of every row to 56 sts, ending on a WS row.

Break MC.

Next row: With Color 2, K1. K2tog.

Knit to end of row. Rep last row to 3 sts.

Next row: K3tog. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew Motifs tog as shown in diagram on page 2, using a flat seam.

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
Border

With RS facing, MC, and circular needle, pick up and knit 240 sts evenly along side edge of Blanket. Do not join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows: Knit 4 rows.

Cast off knitwise (WS). Rep for opposite side edge of

Blanket.

With RS facing, MC and circular needle, pick up and knit 206 sts evenly along top edge of Blanket. Do not join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows: Knit 4 rows. Cast off knitwise (WS). Rep for bottom edge of Blanket.



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
