## MATERIALS

Main Color (MC) Cream (10589)
2 balls
Contrast A Country Rose (10535) 1 ball
Contrast B Dark Pink (10621) 1 ball
Contrast C Scarlet (10516)
1 \text { ball}
```

Size U.S. 8 ( 5 mm ) knitting needles. Size U.S. $8(5 \mathrm{~mm}$ ) circular knitting needle 40 " [101.5 cm ] long or size needed to obtain gauge. Stitch marker.

## KNIT I SKILL LEVEL: EASY

## ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximate(ly)
Beg = Begin(ning)
Inc = Increase(ing)
K = Knit
K2(3)tog = Knit next 2(3) stitches together
$\mathbf{K f b}=$ Increase 1 stitch by knitting into front and back of next stitch.

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx $52 \times 62$ " $[132 \times 157.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].

## GAUGE

16 sts and 28 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in garter st.
Motif = Approx 10" [25.5 cm ] square.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Motif

Make 10 with A as Color 2. Make 10 with B as Color 2. Make 10 with C as Color 2.

Note: It may be helpful to place a removable st marker on RS of work to keep track of RS and WS.

Rep $=$ Repeat
RS $=$ Right side
St(s) $=$ Stitch (es)
Tog = Together
WS = Wrong side

With MC and pair of needles, cast on 3 sts.
1 st row: (RS). Knit.
2nd row: Kfb. Knit to end of row. Rep last row, inc 1 st at beg of every row to 56 sts, ending on a WS row.
Break MC.
Next row:With Color 2, K1. K2tog.
Knit to end of row.
Rep last row to 3 sts.
Next row: K3tog. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Sew Motifs tog as shown in diagram on page 2, using a flat seam.

## CROD TURNING POINTS KNIT BLANKET | KNIT

## Border

With RS facing, MC, and circular needle, pick up and knit 240 sts evenly along side edge of Blanket. Do not join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:
Knit 4 rows.
Cast off knitwise (WS).
Rep for opposite side edge of Blanket.

With RS facing, MC and circular needle, pick up and knit 206 sts evenly along top edge of Blanket. Do not join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:
Knit 4 rows.
Cast off knitwise (WS).
Rep for bottom edge of Blanket.
