## CiO KNIT GINGHAM PANELS BLANKET | KNIT



## MATERIALS

$\begin{array}{lr}\text { Caron }^{\oplus} \text { Kindness }^{\text {TM }}(7 \mathrm{oz} / 198 \mathrm{~g} ; 345 \mathrm{yds} / 315 \mathrm{~m}) \\ \text { Contrast A Soft White ( } 53001 \text { ) } & \mathbf{2} \text { balls } \\ \text { Contrast B Fog ( } 53009 \text { ) } & \mathbf{2} \text { balls } \\ \text { Contrast C Smoke (53012) } & \mathbf{2} \text { balls }\end{array}$
Size U.S. $9(5.5 \mathrm{~mm})$ knitting needles. Size U.S. $9(5.5 \mathrm{~mm})$ circular knitting needle 29" [73.5 cm ] long or size needed to obtain gauge.

## ABBREVIATIONS

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 43" x 49" [109.5 x 121 cm ].

## GAUGE

14 sts and 44 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in pat.

## INSTRUCTIONS

PANEL 1 (make 3).
With A, cast on 21 sts.
1st row: (WS). Knit.
2nd row: K1. *K1below. K1. Rep from * to end of row.
3rd row: Knit.
4th row: K2. *K1below. K1. Rep from * to last st. K1.
5th to 44th rows: Rep 1st to 4th rows 10 times more.
45th row: With A, knit.
46th row: With $B$, as 2nd row. 47th row: With B, knit.

48th row: With A, as 4th row. 49th to 88th rows: Rep 45th to 48th rows 10 times more.
89th row: With A, knit.
90th row: With C, as 2nd row.
91st row: With C, knit.
92nd row: With A, as 4th row.
93rd to 132nd rows: Rep 89th to 92nd rows 10 times more.
Rep last 132 rows twice more. With A, cast off knitwise (WS).

PANEL 2 (make 2).
With B, cast on 21 sts.
1st row: (WS). Knit.
2nd row: With B, K1. *K1below. K1. Rep from * to end of row.
3rd row: With B, knit.
4th row: With A, K2. *K1below. K1. Rep from * to last st. K1.
5th to 44th rows: Rep 1st to 4th rows 10 times more.

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45th to 88th rows: With B only, rep 1st to 4th rows 11 times more. 89th row: With $B$, knit. 90th row: With C, as 2nd row. 91 st row: With C, knit.
92nd row: With B, as 4th row.
93rd to 132nd rows: Rep 89th to 92nd rows 10 times more. Rep last 132 rows twice more. With B, cast off knitwise (WS).

PANEL 3 (make 2).
With C, cast on 21 sts.
1st row: (WS). Knit.
2nd row: With C, K1. *K1below. K1. Rep from * to end of row.
3rd row: With C, knit.
4th row: With A, K2. *K1below.
K1. Rep from * to last st. K1.
5th to 44th rows: Rep 1st to 4th rows 10 times more.
45th row: With C, knit.
46th row: With $B$, as 2nd row.
47th row: With B, knit.
48th row: With C, as 4th row.
49th to 88th rows: Rep 45th to 48th rows 10 times more.
89th to 132nd rows: With C only, rep 1st to 4th rows 11 times more. Rep last 132 rows twice more. With C, cast off knitwise (WS).

## FINISHING

Using flat seam, sew Panels tog as follows: $1,2,3,1,2,3,1$.

Side edging: With RS facing, circular needle and A, pick up and knit 193 sts evenly along side edge of Afghan.
1st row: (WS). Knit.
2nd row: With C, K1. *K1below. K1. Rep from * to end of row.
3rd row: With C, knit.
4th row: With A, knit.
Cast off knitwise (WS).
Rep across opposite side edge.
Top and Bottom edging: With RS facing, circular needle and A, pick up and knit 157 sts evenly across top edge of Afghan.
Work as for side edging.
Rep across bottom edge of Afghan.
