

## MATERIALS

Caron ${ }^{\circledR}$ Simply Soft ${ }^{\text {rm }}$ ( $6 \mathrm{oz} / 170.1 \mathrm{~g} ; 315 \mathrm{yds} / 288 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Contrast A Dark Country Blue (39711) 1 ball
Contrast B Light Country Blue (39709) 2 balls
Contrast C Ocean (39759)
Contrast D Dark Sage (39707)
2 balls

Contrast E Persimmon (39754)
2 balls
2 balls
Contrast F Plum Wine (39722)
1 ball
Size U.S. 11 ( 8 mm ) circular knitting needle 36 " [ 91.5 cm ] long or size needed to obtain gauge.


## ABBREVIATIONS

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Approx = Approximately
Beg=Beginning
Cont = Continue
K= Knit
P = Purl
Pat = Pattern
Rep \(=\) Repeat
RS \(=\) Right side
St(s) = Stitch(es)
WS \(=\) Wrong side
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## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 55" [139.5 cm] wide x 60" [152.5 cm ] long.

## GAUGE

13 sts and 16 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in Rib pat, with 2 strands of yarn held together.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Holding 1 strand each of A and B, cast on 175 sts. Do not join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:
1st row: *K2. P2. Rep from * to last 3 sts. K2. P1.
Rep last row for Rib pat (noting 1st row is RS).
Cont in Rib pat until work from beg measures 12" [ 30.5 cm ], ending on a WS row.

Break A. Join C.
Holding 1 strand each of $B$ and C, cont in Rib pat until work from beg measures 24 " [61 cm], ending on a WS row.

Break B, join D.
Holding 1 strand each of C and D, cont in Rib pat until work from beg measures 36 " $[91.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ], ending on a WS row.

Break C, join E.
Holding 1 strand each of $D$ and $E$, cont in Rib pat until work from beg measures 48" [122 cm], ending on a WS row.

Break D, join F.
Holding 1 strand each of E and F, cont in Rib pat until work from beg measures 60" [ 152.5 cm ], ending on a WS row. Cast off in pat.
