



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Begin(ning)

K = Knit

K1below = Knit into next stitch 1 row below, at same time, slipping off stitch above



K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together

Kfb = Increase 1 stitch by knitting into front and back of next stitch

Pat = Pattern

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 48" x 54" [122 x 137 cm].

GAUGES

15 sts and 28 rows = 4" [10 cm] in garter st.

14 sts and 32 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Bee St.

INSTRUCTIONS

With A, cast on 165 sts.

Knit 15 rows (garter st), noting that 1st row is WS.

Next row: K8. (K2tog. K14) twice. (K2tog. K15) 4 times. (K2tog. K14) 3 times. K2tog. K7. 155 sts.

Proceed in pat as follows:

1st row: (WS). With A, knit.

2nd row: With B, K1. *K1below. K1. Rep from * to end of row.

3rd row: With B, knit.

4th row: With A, K2. *K1below. K1. Rep from * to last st. K1.

Rep these 4 rows for Bee St Pat until work from beg measures approx 52" [132 cm], ending on a 3rd row.

With A, proceed as follows:

Next row: K8. (Kfb. K14) twice. (Kfb. K15) 4 times. (Kfb. K14) 3 times. Kfb. K7. 165 sts.

Knit 15 rows (garter st). Cast off knitwise.

MATERIALS

Caron® One Pound™ (16 oz/453.7 g; 812 yds/742 m)

Contrast A Dark Gray Mix (10618) **2 balls**

Caron® Jumbo™ (12 oz/340 g; 595 yds/544 m)

Contrast B Plum Copper (09048) **2 balls**

Size U.S. 8 (5 mm) circular knitting needle 36" [91.5 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

Border

With A, and RS facing, pick up and knit 203 sts evenly along side edge of Blanket. **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:

Knit 16 rows.

Cast off knitwise (WS).

Rep for opposite side edge of Blanket.
