

## MATERIALS

Caron ${ }^{\circledR}$ One Pound ${ }^{\text {™ }}$ ( $16 \mathrm{oz} / 454 \mathrm{~g} ; 812 \mathrm{yds} / 742 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Contrast A Sunflower (10549) 1 ball
Contrast B Raspberry Pink (10646) 1 ball
Contrast C Living Coral (02003) 1 ball
Contrast D Soft Sage (10580) 1 ball
Size U.S. 10 ( 6 mm ) circular knitting needle 29" [ 74 cm ] long or size needed to obtain gauge. Yarn needle.


## ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately $\quad$ St(s) $=$ Stitch (es)
$\mathbf{B}=$ Beginning
K = Knit
Rem = Remain(ing)
RS = Right side
SI1 Pwyib = Slip next stitch purlwise with yarn in back of work

Tog = Together
$\mathbf{W \& T}=$ Bring yarn to front of work. Slip next stitch purlwise. Bring yarn to back of work. Slip stitch back onto left-hand needle. Turn.
WS = Wrong side

## MEASUREMENT

Approx 59" [150 cm] diameter.

## GAUGE

15 sts and 28 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in garter stitch.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Notes:

- Blanket is worked in a spiral using short-turn rows.
- To change colors, wind 2 colors around each other where they meet, on WS, to avoid a hole

With B, cast on 74 sts. With A, cast on 37 sts. Do not join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:

## First Wedge:

1st row: (WS). With A, SI1Pwyib. K36. With B, K74.
2nd row: (RS). With B, K74. With A, K35. W\&T.
3rd row: With A, SI1Pwyib. K34. With B, K74.
4th row: With B, K74. With A, K34. W\&T.
5th row: With A, SI1Pwyib. K33.
With $B$, knit to end of row.
6th row: With B, K74. With A, K33. W\&T.
7th row: With A, SI1Pwyib. K32. With $B$, knit to end of row.
8th row: With B, K74. With A, K32. W\&T.
9th row: Beg with A, SI1Pwyib. Knit to end or row, matching color.

## CROO KNIT PINWHEEL POSY BLANKET

10th row: Beg with $B$, knit to 1 st before previously wrapped st, matching color. W\&T.

Rep last 2 rows until 2 sts rem unwrapped, ending on a WS row. Next row: (RS) Working across all sts, with C, K74. With A, K37.

Second Wedge: Work as given for First Wedge, substituting C for B.

Third Wedge: Work as given for First Wedge, substituting D for B.

Fourth Wedge: Work as given for First Wedge.

Fifth Wedge: Work as given for Second Wedge.

Sixth Wedge: Work as given for Third Wedge.
Cast off.

## FINISHING

Sew cast on and cast off edges tog using a flat seam and matching colors.
Run length of A through center sts, gather tog tightly and fasten securely.
