

## MATERIALS

Caron ${ }^{\otimes}$ Big Donut ${ }^{\text {Tm }}$ O $^{\prime}$ Go $^{\text {TM }}$ ( $9.9 \mathrm{oz} / 280 \mathrm{~g} ; 502 \mathrm{yds} / 459 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Blue Velvet (29007)
3 O'Gos
Lemon Plum (29002)
3 O'Gos


Size U.S. 8 ( 5 mm ) knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge. T-pins $13 / 4$ " $[4.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] long. Yarn needle. Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook for fringe.


## ABBREVIATIONS

Alt $=$ Alternate
Approx = Approximately K = Knit
Rep $=$ Repeat
RS $=$ Right Side
St(s) = Stitch(es)
Tog = Together

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 50" x 59" [127 x 150 cm], excluding fringe.

## GAUGE

16 sts and 30 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in garter st.

WS = Wrong Side $\mathbf{W} \boldsymbol{Q} \mathbf{T}=$ Bring yarn to front of work. Slip next stitch purlwise. Bring yarn to back of work. Slip stitch back onto left-hand needle. Turn.


## INSTRUCTIONS

## Notes:

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove.
- For this pattern, colors can be easily separated by gently pulling apart and cutting at the color transition. Each color is ready to use.
- Use separated colors from $\mathrm{O}^{\prime}$ Go (Contrast A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J) as indicated in Materials.


## PANEL 1

## First Triangle

With H, cast on 40 sts using 2 needle cable cast-on method. 1st row: (WS). With H, knit. **2nd row: (RS). K38. W\&T. 3rd and alt (WS) rows: Knit. 4th row: K36. W\&T. 6th row: K34. W\&T.
8th row: K32. W\&T.
10th row: K30. W\&T.
12th row: K28. W\&T.
14th row: K26. W\&T.
16th row: K24. W\&T.
18th row: K22. W\&T.
20th row: K20. W\&T.
22nd row: K18. W\&T.
24th row: K16. W\&T.
26th row: K14. W\&T.
28th row: K12. W\&T.
30th row: K10. W\&T.
32nd row: K8. W\&T.
34th row: K6. W\&T.
36th row: K4. W\&T.
38th row: K2. W\&T.
39th row: (WS). Knit. Break H. Join E.

Second Triangle
1st row: (RS). With E, knit across all sts (you do not have to pick up and knit the wraps, just knit as you normally would).
2nd row: K38. W\&T.
3rd and alt (RS) rows: Knit.
4th row: K36. W\&T.
6th row: K34. W\&T.
8th row: K32. W\&T.
10th row: K30. W\&T.
12th row: K28. W\&T.
14th row: K26. W\&T.
16th row: K24. W\&T.
18th row: K22. W\&T.
20th row: K20. W\&T.
22nd row: K18. W\&T.
24th row: K16. W\&T.
26th row: K14. W\&T.
28th row: K12. W\&T.
30th row: K10. W\&T.
32nd row: K8. W\&T.
34th row: K6. W\&T.
36th row: K4. W\&T.
38th row: K2. W\&T.
40th row: (WS). Knit across all sts (you do not have to pick up and knit the wraps, just knit as you normally would). Break E. Join H.** Rep from ${ }^{* *}$ to ${ }^{* *} 10$ times more (22 Triangles).
With E, cast off all sts.

## PANEL 2

## First Triangle

With G, cast on 40 sts using 2 needle cable cast-on method.
**1 st row: (WS). K38. W\&T.
2nd row and alt (RS) rows: Knit.
3rd row: K36. W\&T.
5th row: K34. W\&T.
7th row: K32. W\&T.
9th row: K30. W\&T.
11th row: K28. W\&T.
13th row: K26. W\&T.
15th row: K24. W\&T.
17th row: K22. W\&T.
19th row: K20. W\&T.
2st row: K18. W\&T.
23rd row: K16. W\&T.
25th row: K14. W\&T.
27th row: K12. W\&T.
29th row: K10. W\&T.
31st row: K8. W\&T.
33rd row: K6. W\&T.
35th row: K4. W\&T.
37th row: K2. W\&T.
39th row: (WS). Knit across all sts (you do not have to pick up and knit the wraps, just knit as you normally would). Break G. Join C.

## Second Triangle

1st row: (RS). With C, K38. W\&T.
2nd rowand alt (WS) rows: Knit.
3rd row: K36. W\&T.
5th row: K34. W\&T.
7th row: K32. W\&T.
9th row: K30. W\&T.
11th row: K28. W\&T.
13th row: K26. W\&T.
15th row: K24. W\&T.
17th row: K22. W\&T.
19th row: K20. W\&T.
21st row: K18. W\&T.
23rd row: K16. W\&T.
25th row: K14. W\&T.
27th row: K12. W\&T.
29th row: K10. W\&T.
31 st row: K8. W\&T.
33rd row: K6. W\&T.
35 row: K4. W\&T.
37th row: K2. W\&T.
38th row: (WS). Knit. *** Break C. Join G.
39th row: (RS). With G, knit across all sts (you do not have to pick up and knit the wraps, just knit as you normally would).**

Rep from ** to ** 9 times more, then from ${ }^{* *}$ to ${ }^{* * *}$ once. (22 Triangles).
With C, cast off all sts.

## COB KNIT SAWTOOTH PANELS BLANKET

PANEL 3
Work as for Panel 1, substituting J for H and B for E .

PANEL 4
Work as for Panel 2, substituting I for $G$ and $A$ for $C$.

## PANEL 5

Work as for Panel 1, substituting F for $H$ and $D$ for $E$.

## FINISHING

Block each Panel into rectangles measuring approx. $91 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ [24 cm] wide x 55 " [139.5 cm ] long.
Pin Panels tog, taking care to match sides of Triangles, lining up cast on edge across bottoms and blocking/ adjusting Panels to straighten as needed. Sew tog with flat seam in this order: Panel 1, 2, 3, 4, 5.


FLAT SEAM

Fringe: Cut 68 lengths of each color $15^{\prime \prime}$ [ 38 cm ] long. Using contrasting shade to match Panel at each end, taking 4 strands tog, knot into fringe, spacing 17 fringes evenly across end of each Panel (see photo). Trim fringe evenly.
