



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: **BEGINNER**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately
Beg = Begin(ning)(s)
Rep = Repeat
St(s) = Stitch(es)
Tog = Together
WS = Wrong side

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 50" x 60" [127 cm x 152.5 cm].

GAUGE

17 stitches (sts) and 32 rows = 4" [10 cm] in garter stitch (st).

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- Work 2 rows from first cake as Color 1, then work 2 rows from second cake as Color 2 throughout, noting colors should not match from 2 different cakes. When starting new cake, take care to match color change stripe in cake to keep the striping pattern consistent.
- Leftover yarn can be used later to match up as needed.

BLANKET

Wide Panel (make 3)

With Color 1, cast on 45 sts.

- 1st row:** (Wrong side - WS). Knit.
2nd and 3rd rows: With Color 2, knit.
4th and 5th rows: With Color 1, knit.

Repeat (Rep) Rows 2-5 until work from beginning (beg) measures approximately (approx) 60" [152.5 cm], ending on Row 2 or 4. Cast off.

Narrow Panel (make 4)

With Color 2, cast on 15 sts.

- 1st row:** (WS). Knit.
2nd and 3rd rows: With Color 1, knit.
4th and 5th rows: With Color 2, knit.

MATERIALS

Caron® Cakes™ (8.5 oz/240 g; 445 yds/407 m)

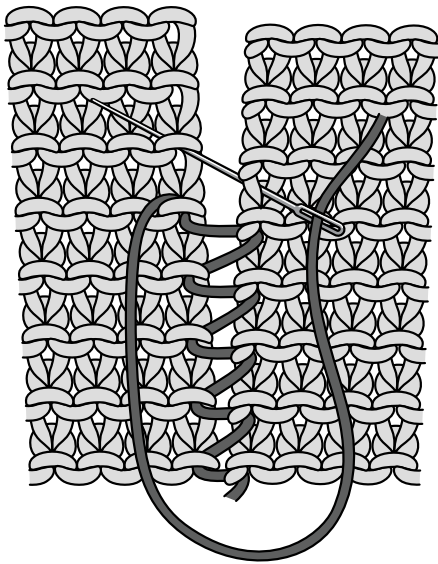
Fruit Frosting (49009)

5 balls

Size U.S 8 (5 mm) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
 Yarn needle.

Rep 2nd to 5th rows until work from beg measures same length as Wide Panel, ending on 2nd or 4th row. Cast off.

Beg with Narrow Panel and alternating Panels, sew Panels together (tog), using flat seam (see photo).



FLAT SEAM
