Caront ${ }^{\oplus}$ One Pound ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ ( $16 \mathrm{oz} / 454 \mathrm{~g} ; 812 \mathrm{yds} / 742 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Contrast A Aqua 10622)
Contrast B Ocean (10611)
1 ball or $415 \mathrm{yds} / 375 \mathrm{~m}$

Contrast C
Contrast D Lt Terracotta (10626) $\mathbf{1}$ ball or $\mathbf{3 1 0} \mathbf{y d s} / \mathbf{2 8 0} \mathbf{~ m}$
Contrast E Faded Brick (10653)
Contrast F Peach (10504)
Contrast G Sunflower (10549)
1 ball or $310 \mathrm{yds} / \mathbf{2 8 0} \mathrm{m}$
1 ball or $400 \mathrm{yds} / 360 \mathrm{~m}$ 1 ball or $345 \mathrm{yds} / 310 \mathrm{~m}$ 1 ball or $365 \mathrm{yds} / 330 \mathrm{~m}$ 1 ball or 45 yds/40 m
Size U.S. 8 ( 5 mm ) Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ circular knitting needle 36 " $[90 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] long or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ stitch markers.

## ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately
Pat $=$ Pattern

K = Knit
K2tog $=$ Knit next 2 stitches together
M1 = Make 1 stitch by picking up horizontal loop lying before next stitch and knitting into back of loop


Rep $=$ Repeat
$\mathbf{R S}=$ Right side
SI1Pwyib = Slip next stitch purlwise with yarn in back of work
Ssk = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together St(s) = Stitch(es)
WS = Wrong side
Yo = Yarn over

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx $48 \times 60$ " $[122 \times 152.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].

## GAUGE

18 sts and 24 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in stocking st.

## INSTRUCTIONS

With A, cast on 230 sts. Do not join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, knit 8 rows noting first row is WS.

Next row: (WS). (K11. M1) 20 times. Knit to end of row. 250 sts. (multiple of 61 sts +6 )

Proceed in 4-Wave pat as follows: **1st row: K3. *(K2tog) 10 times. (K1. yo) 20 times. K1. (ssk) 10 times. Rep from * to last 3 sts. K3
2nd row: K3. Purl to last 3 sts. K3. 3rd row: Knit.
4th to 7th rows: As 2nd and 3rd rows twice.
8th row: As 2nd row.

## CROB SUNSET KNIT BLANKET

Rep 1st to 8th rows 4 times more, then 1st to row once.

Beg with a knit row, knit 11 rows (garter st).** Break A.

With B, rep from ** to ** once more.

With C, rep from ** to ** once more.

With D, rep from ** to ** once more.

With E, rep from ** to ** once more.
With F, rep from ** to ** once more.
Next row: (RS). With F, (K10. K2tog) 20 times. Knit to end of row. 230 sts.
Knit 8 rows (garter st). Cast off knitwise (WS).

## Sun Appliquè

With G, cast on 21 sts.
1st row: (WS). Knit.
***2nd and alt rows: SI1Pwyib.
Knit to end of row.
3rd row: K19. Turn.
5th row: K17.Turn.
7th row: K15. Turn.
9th row: K13. Turn.
11th row: K11. Turn.
13th row: K9. Turn.
15th row: K7. Turn.
17th row: K5. Turn.
19th row: K3. Turn.
20th row: SI1Pwyib. Knit to end of row.
21st row: Knit across all sts.***
This completes first wedge of Sun. Rep from ${ }^{* * *}$ to ***. 5 Wedges completed. Cast off.

Sew Sun Appliquè as shown in picture.
