## KNIT I SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

Approximately

**Cont** = Continue(ity)

 $\mathbf{K} = Knit$ 

**K2tog** = Knit next 2 stitches together

M1 = Make 1 stitch

by picking up horizontal loop lying before next stitch

and knitting into back of loop

 $\mathbf{P} = Purl$ 

**Pat** = Pattern

**Pss2o** = Pass slipped stitch over last 2 knit

stitches

**Rep** = Repeat

**RS** = Right side

**SI1P** = Slip next stitch purlwise

**SI1Pwyib** = Slip next stitch purlwise, with varn at back of work

**SI1Pwyif** = Slip next stitch purlwise, with yarn in front of work

**Ssk** = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-

hand needle, then knit through back loops together

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**WS** = Wrong side

**Caron**® **Jumbo Twirl**™ (12 oz/340 g; 578 yds/528 m)

**Main Color (MC)** 

Off White Ribbon (83003)

**Contrast A** Canal Ribbon (83001)

**Contrast B** Mustard Ribbon (83010)

**Contrast C** Violet Ribbon (83008)

3 balls or 1350 yds/1230 m

1 ball or 450 yds/410 m

1 ball or 285 yds/260 m

1 ball or 285 yds/260 m

Sizes U.S. 8 (5 mm) and U.S. 9 (5.5 mm) Susan Bates® circular knitting needles 36" [91.5 cm] long or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates® yarn needle.



Approx 52" x 63" [132 x 160 cm].

### **GAUGE**

15.5 sts and 19 rows = 4" [10 cm] with larger needles in stocking st.

## **INSTRUCTIONS**

With smaller, circular needle and MC, cast on 201 sts. **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, knit 8 rows (garter st), noting 1st row is WS and ending on a RS row.

**Next row:** (WS). K10. (M1. K20) 9 times. M1. Knit to end of row. 211 sts.



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Change to larger, circular needle and proceed in Chain Pat as follows:

1st row: Knit.

2nd row: K5. Purl to last 5 sts. K5.



3rd row: With A, knit.

4th row: With A, K5. \*K1. Sl1Pwyib.

Rep from \* to last 6 sts. K6.

**5th row:** With A, K5. \*SI1Pwyif. P1.

Rep from \* to last 6 sts. K6.

6th row: With MC, as 2nd row.

**7th to 10th rows:** With MC, as 1st

and 2nd rows twice.

11th row: With B. knit.

12th and 13th rows: With B, as 4th

and 5th rows.

14th row: With MC, as 2nd row.

15th to 18th rows: With MC, as 1st and 2nd rows twice.

**19th row:** With C, knit.

20th and 21st rows: With C, as 4th

and 5th rows.

22nd row: With MC, as 2nd row.

23rd to 26th rows: With MC, as 1st

and 2nd rows twice.

These 26 rows form Chain Pat.

**Next row:** (RS). With MC, K10. (K2tog. K19) 9 times. K2tog. Knit to end of row. 201 sts.

**Next row:** K5. Purl to last 5 sts. K5. Break MC

Proceed in Lace Mesh Pat (multiple of 3 sts + 12) as follows:

**1st row:** With A, K7. \*yo. Sl1P. K2. pss2o. Rep from \* to last 5 sts. K5.

**2nd row:** K5. Purl to last 5 sts. K5.

**3rd row:** K6. \*yo. SI1P. K2. pss2o. Rep from \* to last 6 sts. K6.

4th row: K5. Purl to last 5 sts. K5. Rep last 4 rows of Lace Mesh Pat, with 5 garter sts at each side edge, for 5" [12.5 cm], ending on a WS row. Break A.

With MC, rep last 4 rows of Lace Mesh Pat once. Break MC.

With B, cont in Lace Mesh Pat for 5" [12.5 cm], ending on a WS row. Break B.

Next row: (RS). With MC, K10. (M1. K20) 9 times. M1. Knit to end of row. 211 sts.

**Next row:** K5. Purl to last 5 sts. K5.

Work 26 rows of Chain Pat, keeping 5 garter sts at each side edge of Blanket.

Next row: (RS). With MC, knit **Next row:** K5. Purl to last 5 sts. K5.

Proceed in Eyelet Pat as follows:

1st row: With MC, knit.

2nd row: K5. Purl to last 5 sts. Knit. 3rd to 20th rows: As 1st and 2nd rows 9 times more. (20 rows total).

**21st row:** K11. (yo. ssk. K15)

11 times. yo. ssk. K11.

22nd row: K5. Purl to last 5 sts. K5. 23rd to 40th rows: As 1st and 2nd rows 9 times more. (20 rows total).

**41st row:** K20. (yo. ssk. K15) 10 times. yo. ssk. K19.

**42nd row:** As 2nd row.

Rep 1st to 42nd rows of Eyelet Pat, with 5 garter sts at each side edge, for approx 15" [38 cm], ending on 20th or 40th row of pat.

**Next row:** (RS). With MC, knit Next row: K5. Purl to last 5 sts. K5.

Work 26 rows of Chain Pat, keeping 5 garter sts at each side edge.

**Next row:** (RS). With MC, K10. (K2tog. K19) 9 times. K2tog. Knit to end of row. 201 sts.

**Next row:** K5. Purl to last 5 sts. K5.

With C, work in Lace Mesh Pat for 5" [12.5 cm], keeping 5 garter sts at each side edge and ending on a WS row.

With MC, work 4 rows in Lace Mesh Pat, keeping 5 garter sts at each side edge.

With A, cont in Lace Mesh Pat for 5" [12.5 cm], keeping 5 garter sts at each side and ending on a WS row. Break A.

**Next row:** (RS). With MC, K10. (M1. K20) 9 times. M1. Knit to end of row. 211 sts.

**Next row:** K5. Purl to last 5 sts. K5.

Work 3rd to 20th rows of Chain Pat once, then rep 3rd to 18th rows once, keeping 5 garter sts at each side edge.

Next row: (RS). With MC, K10. (K2tog. K19) 9 times. K2tog. Knit to end of row. 201 sts.



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Knit 8 rows (garter st), noting 1st row is WS and ending on a RS row. Cast off knitwise (WS).

#### **FINISHING**

Pin Blanket to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth leaving cloth to dry.

Using yarn needle, embroider Diamond Eyelet stitch around each eyelet as shown on diagram, changing colors randomly.
