

## MATERIALS

Caron ${ }^{\circledR}$ Jumbo Twirl ${ }^{\text {Tm }}$ ( 12 oz/340 g; 578 yds/528 m)
Contrast A Off White Ribbon (83003) 1 ball or $\mathbf{4 0 0}$ yds/364 m
Contrast B Terra Cotta Ribbon (83009) $\mathbf{1}$ ball or $\mathbf{4 2 0} \mathbf{y d s} / \mathbf{3 8 2} \mathbf{~ m}$
Contrast C Iris Ribbon (83013) 1 ball or $400 \mathrm{yds} / 364 \mathrm{~m}$
Contrast D Mustard Ribbon (83010)
Contrast E Canal Ribbon (83001)
1 ball or $380 \mathrm{yds} / 346 \mathrm{~m}$

Size U.S. 8 ( 5 mm ) Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Silvalume ${ }^{\circledR}$ circular knitting needle $36 "\left[91.5 \mathrm{~cm}\right.$ ] long or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ yarn needle.


## ABBREVIATIONS

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx $46 \times 55$ " $[117 \times 139.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].

## GAUGES

15 sts and 30 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in garter st (knit every row).
Block = Approx 9" [23 cm] square.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Note: See Block color placement diagrams on page 3.

BLOCK 1 (make 10)
Color $1=B$
Color $2=\mathrm{C}$
Color 3 = A
Color $4=\mathrm{E}$
work. Slip next stitch purlwise. Bring yarn to back of work. Slip stitch back onto left-hand needle. Turn.


Triangle 1: With Color 1, cast on 33 sts.
**1st row: (RS). Knit.
2nd row: K31.W\&T.
3rd row: Knit.
4th row: Knit to 2 sts before last wrapped st. W\&T.

## 5th row: Knit.

Rep last 2 rows until 3 sts rem.
Next row: (WS). K1. W\&T.
Next row: K1.
Next row: K33.** Break Color 1.
Triangle 2: With Color 2, proceed as follows:
1st row: (RS). Knit.
2nd row: Knit.
3rd row: K1.W\&T.

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4th row: Knit.
5th row: Knit to 1 st after last wrapped st. W\&T.
6th row: Knit.
Rep last 2 rows until 1 st rem after wrapped st and last row is K31. (1 st rem unworked after last wrapped st. 1 st row of next Triangle is worked across all 33 sts). Break Color 2.

Triangle 3: With Color 3, as Triangle 1 from ${ }^{* *}$ to ${ }^{* *}$. Break Color 3.

Triangle 4: With Color 4, as Triangle 2. Cast off all 33 sts purlwise at end of last row.

## BLOCK 2 (make 5)

Color 1 = D
Color $2=\mathrm{B}$
Color 3 = C
Color 4 = A
Work as for Block 1.
BLOCK 3 (make 5)
Color 1 = E
Color $2=\mathrm{D}$
Color $3=\mathrm{B}$
Color 4 = C
Work as for Block 1.

BLOCK 4 (make 5)
Color 1 = A
Color 2 = D
Color $3=\mathrm{E}$
Color 4 = B
Work as for Block 1.

BLOCK 5 (make 5)
Color 1 = C
Color 2 = A
Color 3 = E
Color 4 = D
Work as for Block 1.

## FINISHING

Pin Blocks to measure 9" [23 cm ] square. Cover with a damp cloth leaving cloth to dry.
Following Assembly Diagram on page 3, sew Blocks tog rotating Blocks as shown.

Tip: Joining Blocks into 6 strips of 5 Blocks is recommended, then sew strips tog

Bottom Edging: With RS facing and E, pick up and knit 160 sts evenly across lower edge (32 sts across each Block).
Work 4 rows garter st (knit every row).
Cast off knitwise (WS).

Right Side Edging: With RS facing and E, pick up and knit 196 sts evenly along right side edge (32 sts across each Block and 4 sts across side of Bottom Edging).
Work 4 rows garter st (knit every row).
Cast off knitwise (WS).

Top Edging: With RS facing and E, pick up and knit 164 sts evenly along top edge ( 32 sts across each Block and 4 sts across side of Side Edging).
Work 4 rows garter st (knit every row).
Cast off knitwise (WS).

Block $1 \times 10$

Left Side Edging: With RS facing and E, pick up and knit 198 sts evenly along left side edge (4 sts across side of Top Edging, 32 sts across each Block and 4 sts across side of Bottom Edging).
Work 4 rows garter st (knit every row).
Cast off knitwise (WS).
