Ginger Spice (20002) 2 balls
Size U.S. $1012(6.5 \mathrm{~mm})$ knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge. 20" [51 cm ] square pillow form.

## ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximate(ly)
Beg $=$ Begin(ning)
K = Knit
Loop $=$ Knit into next stitch, drawing up a loop long enough to fit around thumb, but do not take stitch off left-hand needle. Hold long loop to front of work and knit into back of same stitch to secure loop, then slip stitch off needle.

## MEASUREMENT

Approx. 20" [51 cm] square

## GAUGE

13 sts and 16 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in stocking st;
12 sts and 18 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in Loop St

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Front

Note: To secure loops, take time to pull each loop securely to RS of work after each Loop row in pat is worked.

Pat = Pattern $\mathbf{P}=$ Purl
Rep = Repeat
RS $=$ Right side
St(s) = Stitch(es)
WS = Wrong side

## COB GOING LOOPY KNIT PILLOW | KNIT

2nd row: *K1. P1. Rep from * to last st. K1.
Rep last 2 rows once more (4 rows total).
Proceed in stocking st until work from beg measures 13 " $[33 \mathrm{~cm}$ ], ending on a purl row.
Cast off.

## FINISHING

Overlap Back pieces to match Front, with ribbed sections in center to create opening to insert pillow form. Sew outer edge seams.
