

MATERIALS

 Caron® Big Donut™ O'Go™ (9.9 oz/280 g; 502 yds/459 m)

 Raspberry Glazed (29006)
 2 O'Gos



Size U.S. 5 (3.75 mm) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch marker. Yarn needle. Stuffing.





💯 KNIT I SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

pprox = Approximately
K = Knit
PM = Place marker
Rep = Repeat
Rnd(s) = round(s)
RS = Right side
St(s) = Stitch(es)
Tog = Together
WS = Wrong side

W&T = Bring yarn to front of work. Slip next stitch purlwise. Bring yarn to back of work. Slip stitch back onto left-hand needle. Turn. When working the wrapped stitch in next row, pick up the wrap and work it tog with the wrapped stitch



MEASUREMENT

Approx 20" [51 cm] diameter. "Hole" Approx 3½" [9 cm] diameter.

GAUGE

19 sts and 36 rows = 4" [10 cm] in garter st.

INSTRUCTIONS

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove.

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- For this pattern, colors can be easily separated by gently pulling apart and cutting at the color transition. Each color is ready to use. Follow color guide shown in Materials section for each O'Go (Contrast A, B, C, D and E). You may find it helpful to place each color section in its own resealable (zip lock) bag and label each bag A, B, C, D and E
- Start knitting!

FRONT

First Wedge

With A, cast on 43 sts. **1st row:** (WS). Knit. ****2nd row:** K41. W&T. **3rd row:** Knit to end of row. **4th row:** K40. W&T. PM on W&T stitch. **5th row:** As 3rd row. **6th row:** Knit to 2 sts before

marked st. W&T. PM on W&T stitch. **7th row:** As 3rd row.

Rep last 2 rows until row: **"Next row:** (WS). K4" has been completed.

Next row: (RS). Knit across all sts, knitting each st tog with extra wrap. 43 sts. Knit 19 rows, ending on a WS row. Break A. **

Second Wedge

Next 2 rows: With B, knit. Rep from ** to ** substituting B for A.

Third Wedge

Next 2 rows: With C, knit. Rep from ** to ** substituting C for A.

Fourth Wedge

Next 2 rows: With D, knit. Rep from ** to ** substituting D for A.

Fifth Wedge

Next 2 rows: With E, knit. Rep from ** to ** substituting E for A.

Sixth Wedge

Next 2 rows: With C, knit. Rep from ** to ** substituting C for A. Cast off. Sew cast on and cast off edges tog.

BACK First Wedge With E, cast on 43 sts. 1st row: (WS). Knit.

Rep from ** to ** as given for Front, substituting E for A.

Second Wedge

Next 2 rows: With D, knit. Rep from ** to ** as given for Front, substituting D for A.

Third Wedge

Next 2 rows: With C, knit. Rep from ** to ** as given for Front, substituting C for A.

Fourth Wedge

Next 2 rows: With B, knit. Rep from ** to ** as given for Front, substituting D for A.

Fifth Wedge Next 2 rows: With A, knit. Rep from ** to ** as given for Front.

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Sixth Wedge Next 2 rows: With C, knit. Rep from ** to ** as given for Front, substituting C for A. Cast off. Sew cast on and cast off edges tog.

FINISHING

Sew seam of inner hole, using flat seam and matching colors of Front and Back.

Sew outside seam, using flat seam and matching colors of Front and Back and leave 6" [15 cm] opening for stuffing. Stuff Pillow. Sew opening closed.
