## MATERIALS

Caron ${ }^{\ominus}$ Simply Soft ${ }^{\ominus}$ ( $6 \mathrm{oz} / 170.1 \mathrm{~g} ; 315 \mathrm{yds} / 288 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Sage (39705) ball

Size U.S. $8(5 \mathrm{~mm})$ knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge.

## SIZE

One size to fit average Adult.

## GAUGE

17 stitches and 29 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in Seed Stitch Pattern.

## INSTRUCTIONS

HAT
Cast on 86 stiches (sts).
1st row: (Right Side - RS). *Knit (K)1. Purl (P)1. Repeat (Rep) from * to end of row.

2nd row: *P1. K1. Rep from * to end of row.

Rep last 2 rows for Seed St Pattern (pat) until work from beginning (beg) measures approximately (approx) 7" [18 cm ], ending on a Wrong Side (WS) row.

Shape top: 1st row: (RS). K1. *Purl next 3 sts together (P3tog). (K1. P1) 9 times. Knit next 3 sts together (K3tog). (P1. K1) 9 times. Rep from * once more. P1. 78 sts.
2nd and alternate (alt) rows: *P1. K1.
Rep from * to end of row.

3rd row: K1. *P3tog. (K1. P1) 8 times K3tog. (P1. K1) 8 times. Rep from * once more. P1. 70 sts.
5th row: K1. *P3tog. (K1. P1) 7 times K3tog. (P1. K1) 7 times. Rep from * once more. P1. 62 sts.

7th row: K1. *P3tog. (K1. P1) 6 times K3tog. (P1. K1) 6 times. Rep from * once more. P1. 54 sts.
9th row: K1. *P3tog. (K1. P1) 5 times K3tog. (P1. K1) 5 times. Rep from * once more. P1. 46 sts.

11th row: K1. *P3tog. (K1. P1) 4 times. K3tog. (P1. K1) 4 times. Rep from * once more. P1. 38 sts.

13th row: K1. *P3tog. (K1. P1) 3 times. K3tog. (P1. K1) 3 times. Rep from * once more. P1. 30 sts.
15th row: K1. *P3tog. (K1. P1) twice. K3tog. (P1. K1) twice. Rep from * once more. P1. 22 sts.

17th row: K1. *P3tog. K1. P1. K3tog. P1. K1. Rep from * once more. P1. 14 sts. Break yarn, leaving a long end. Draw end tightly through rem sts and fasten securely. Sew center back seam.
