



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: BEGINNER

MEASUREMENT

Approx. 50" [127 cm] long.

INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1: Lay the end of your yarn on your left palm (right palm if left-handed) leaving a tail approximately 6" [15 cm] long.

Step 2: With your right hand, wrap yarn clockwise around your left-hand index finger.

Step 3: Wrap yarn clockwise around middle, ring and pinkie finger, as in Step 2. You now have four loops – one on each finger and no loop on thumb.

Step 4: Bring the yarn up between the thumb and index finger of your left hand. Lay the yarn across your left-hand fingers above the loops.

Step 5: Lift the loop from your pinky finger up and over the yarn lying across your hand, dropping the loop off of your finger. One loop remains on finger.

Step 6: Repeat Step 5 for ring, middle and index fingers. One row is complete.

Step 7: Repeat Steps 4-6 until work measures approximately 50" [127 cm] or desired length.

Step 8: Cut yarn, leaving a tail approximately 6" [15 cm] long. Thread tail onto needle and draw through each loop on fingers.

Step 9: Remove fingers from loops and draw up yarn tightly, knotting to secure.



MATERIALS

Caron® Simply Soft® (6 oz/170.1 g; 315 yds/288 m)
Neon Coral (39772) **1 ball**

Yarn needle and scissors.
