Colorful appliquéd Easter eggs bounce along this bordered runner—a perfect accessory for that special brunch.

Supplies

- Coats Dual Duty XP® All-purpose Thread
- Coats® Cotton Machine Quilting Thread
- $5" \times 7"$ (12.70cm x 17.78cm) scraps of 5 assorted prints for eggs

Featured: Kaffe Fassett Classics in Paperweight PWGP020.GOLD, BLUE, RED; Roman Glass PWGP001. EMERA, and Millefiori GP92.GREEN

- 1/8 yd (11.43cm) each of 5 assorted pastel solids **Featured:** FreeSpirit Designer Essentials Solids
- 3/8 yd (34.29cm) white solid fabric for background
- 1/3 yd (30.48cm) binding fabric
- 11/8 yd (1.03m) backing fabric
- ½ yd (45.72cm) batting
- Paper-back fusible web



EASTER EGG TABLE RUNNER | OUILTING

Cutting

WOF = Width Of Fabric

From each of the 5 assorted pastel solids, cut: (2) strips, $2\frac{1}{2}$ " \times $8\frac{1}{2}$ " (6.35cm \times 21.59cm)

From 2 of the pastel solids, cut: (1) strip, 2½" x 14½" (6.35cm x 36.83cm)

From the white solid, cut: (1) strip, 10½" x 40½" (26.67cm x 102.87cm)

From the binding fabric, cut: (4) strips, 2¼" x WOF (5.72cm x WOF)

From the backing fabric, cut: (2) strips, 18" x WOF (45.72cm x WOF)

Preparation

- Trace 5 egg shapes onto the paper backing of fusible web. Rough-cut the shapes ¼" (.64cm) outside the line.
- Fuse each egg to the wrong side of a 5" x 7" (12.70cm x 17.78cm) scrap and cut out on the marked line.

Assembling the Center

- 1. Peel off the backing paper from the egg shapes and arrange as desired down the center of the white fabric strip.
- 2. Following the manufacturer's instructions, fuse the eggs in place.
- Using a narrow zigzag and matching thread, appliqué the eggs in place. Bring the thread ends to the back and tie off.

Note: Seam allowances are 1/4" (.64cm).


Assembling the Borders

- 1. Randomly sew together (5) 2 ½" x 8 ½" (6.35cm x 21.59cm) pastel strips end to end. Press the seams open. Repeat to make a second strip.
- 2. Sew (1) strip to each long edge of the appliquéd runner center. Press seams toward the borders.
- 3. Sew (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (6.35cm x 36.83cm) pastel strip to each end of the runner. Press seams toward the border.

Assembling the Runner

- 1. Sew together the short edges of the two backing pieces and trim to 52" (132.08cm) long. Press seams open.
- Layer the runner (right side up) over the batting and backing (wrong side up) and quilt as desired using Coats Machine Quilting thread in contrasting colors.
- 3. Trim the backing and batting to match the runner edges.
- 4. Sew the binding strips end to end using diagonal seams. Trim the seam allowances to ¼" (.64cm) and press open. Press the binding in half, wrong sides together.
- 5. Bind the runner outer edges, mitering the corners.
- 6. Turn the binding to the runner underside and handstitch the folded edge in place.





This square should measure 1" x 1" (2.54cm x 2.54cm) when printed.
