MATERIALS

Coats & Clark™ Dual Duty XP™ All-Purpose Thread

1½ yds (1.03m) solid cotton 1/4 yd (22.86cm) each of three fall theme prints



SEWING I SKILL LEVEL: EASY

Featuring Coats & Clark™ Dual Duty XP™ All-Purpose Thread

Be extra fancy for Thanksgiving with the fall inspired apron. It's colorful wedges over a solid underskirt will give off a 50's vibe while you prepare (or order!) the traditional feast.

MEASUREMENTS

19" (48.26cm) long

CUTTING

From the solid cotton, cut:

- (1) rectangle, 24" x width-of-fabric (60.96cm x WOF), for underskirt
- (2) strips, 4" x 28" (10.16cm x 71.12cm), for ties
- (1) strip, 4" x 26" (10.16cm x 66.04cm), for waistband

From each of the fall prints, cut:

(2) wedges, using the pattern provided on page 3.

Seam allowances are 1/4" (.64cm).

ASSEMBLING

Overskirt

- 1. Fold the wider end of each wedge in half and sew across the straight edge. Press the seam open.
- 2. Turn the wedge right side out and center the seam across the wedge width. Press firmly to form the point. Repeat for each wedge.
- 3. Lay out the wedges in the desired arrangement and sew together the long edges.
- 4. Narrowly double hem the outside edges of the wedge grouping.

Underskirt

- 1. Trim the selvages on the rectangle and narrowly double hem each short edge.
- 2. Sew a gathering stitch along the upper rectangle edge.



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- 3. Press up a 4 ½" (11.43cm) hem along the lower rectangle edge. Unfold the hem and press under 1/4" (.64cm) at the top of the hem.
- 4. Refold the hem in place and topstitch the upper edge in place.

Apron


- 1. Matching centers and side edges, place the wedges over the underskirt and pull up the gathering stitches to match the wedges. Stitch in place along the apron skirt upper edge.
- 2. With right sides together and matching centers, place the waistband along the apron upper edge. Note that the band will be longer than the skirt. Stitch in place and press the seam toward the waistband.
- 3. Fold the waistband to the underside, turn under the long edge ¼" (.64cm) and overlap the stitching line. Hand-stitch the waistband in place, leaving the ends open. Press.

- 4. To make the ties, narrowly double hem the long edges and one short end of each tie.
- 5. Tuck in each open end of the waistband so it's even with the skirt side edge and press.
- 6. Form a pleat in each unfinished tie end to make it the same width as the waistband. Both pleats should face the same direction. Tuck each pleated tie end into the waistband end opening ½" (1.27cm).
- 7. Stitch across the waistband to secure each tie end.





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This square should measure 1" x 1" (2.54cm x 2.54cm) when printed.
