



MATERIALS

Coats & Clark™ Dual Duty XP® All-Purpose thread

1½ yd. (1.4m) print fabric for bin
 1½ yd. (1.4m) solid fabric for lining
 1½ yd. (1.4m) heavy weight interfacing

MEASUREMENTS

15¾" w x 14" h (40cm x 35.5cm)

CUTTING

Bin Fabric: 1 rectangle 15" x 48¼" (38cm x 122.5cm), 1 circle 15¾" (40cm) diameter

Lining Fabric: 1 rectangle 15" x 48¼" (38cm x 122.5cm), 1 circle 15¾" (40cm) diameter

Interfacing: rectangle 15" x 48¼" (38cm x 122.5cm), 1 circle 15¾" (40cm) diameter

SEWING

All seam allowances are ½" (1cm).

1. Following manufacturer's instructions, fuse the interfacing to wrong side of lining rectangle and circle.
2. Stitch 15" ends of bin fabric together to make a tube. Repeat with lining fabric. Press seams open.
3. Stitch around one end of each tube ⅜" (1cm) from the edge. Clip at 1" (2.5cm) intervals to the stitching line.
4. Fold circles in half and mark in the seam allowance. Fold again to form quarters of the circle and mark in the seam allowance. Fold the tubes in quarters and mark at the edge of one end of the tube in the seam allowance.
5. Place circle of bin fabric wrong side down. Pin right side of clipped edge of bin fabric tube to right side of bin fabric circle matching quarter marks. Stitch around pinned tube and circle.
6. Repeat for the lining tube and circle.

7. Turn the bin wrong side out and slip the lining into the bin, right sides together. Stitch around the top leaving about 8" unstitched. Put your hand inside the 8" hole and pull the bin fabric through, turning the right side of the bin out and the lining inside the bin. Press around all seams and allowance at the top.
8. Edgestitch around the top closing the 8" hole.
