## Coats \& Clark ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ Dual Duty XP ${ }^{\oplus}$ All-purpose thread Coats \& Clark ${ }^{\text {™ }}$ Dual Duty Plus ${ }^{\circledR}$ Hand Quilting thread <br> Anchor Floss ${ }^{\circledR}$ Floss on Spools <br> Red Heart ${ }^{\circledR}$ Super Saver yarn, Perfect Pink <br> $1 / 2$ yard (.46) of linen <br> $1 / 2$ yard (.46) of pink for letters and binding <br> $1 / 8$ yard (.11m) of gold for jingle bells <br> $1 / 4$ yard (.23m) of Pink/gold cotton for banner bottom Cotton batting <br> $1 / 4$ yard (.23m) Heavy weight fusible interfacing <br> Red Heart ${ }^{\oplus}$ Pom \& Tassel Maker ${ }^{T M}$ <br> Paper backed fusible web (like Steam A Steam ${ }^{\circledR}$ ) <br> Quilting or Betweens needle, Size 8 or 9

## SEWING, QUILTING । SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

## Featuring Coats \& Clark ${ }^{T M}$ Dual Duty XP ${ }^{\oplus}$ All-purpose thread,

 Coats \& Clark ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ Dual Duty Plus ${ }^{\circledR}$ Hand Quilting thread, Anchor Floss ${ }^{\circledR}$ Floss on Spools \& Red Heart ${ }^{\oplus}$ Super SaverCelebrate and "Be Jolly"! Combine quilting and applique to create the banner, then embellish with unique Red Heart ${ }^{\circledR}$ yarn and Anchor ${ }^{\circledR}$ Embroidery floss cord and tassels.

## MEASUREMENTS

$27 "$ H x 16 " W ( $68.5 \mathrm{~cm} \times 40.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), excluding tassels

## PREP THE LINEN:

1. Using pulled threads to keep the fabric on grain, cut a rectangle 16" x 21 " (41cm x 53 cm ) for banner front.
2. Place the linen on cotton batting.
3. Using Coats \& Clark ${ }^{T M}$ Dual Duty Plus ${ }^{\circledR}$ Hand Quilting thread, quilt a line in the center of the linen rectangle, parallel to the $21 "(53 \mathrm{~cm})$ edge.
4. Quilt four rows $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $(4 \mathrm{~cm})$ apart
 on each side of the center row of quilting. You will have 2 " ( 5 cm ) on each side.

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## CUT:

## From linen:

16 " x 21 " $(41 \mathrm{~cm} \times 53 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) for banner back

## From pink/gold cotton:

Two rectangles $16^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 4$ " $(41 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ $18 \mathrm{~cm})$

## From heavy weight fusible

 interfacing:Two rectangles $16^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 4$ " $(41 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ 18 cm )

## From pink for binding and letters:

$21 / 2^{\prime \prime}(6 \mathrm{~cm})$ strips equaling 80 running inches ( 204 cm ) for binding

## ASSEMBLE

1. Trace the letters and the jingle bells onto the gridded side of fusible web.
2. Remove the un-traced paper backing.
3. Place them onto the wrong side of the pink fabrics.
4. Press lightly following the fusible web manufacturer's instructions.
5. Cut out the letters and jingle bells.
6. Remove the paper backing.
7. Arrange the letters on the quilted linen following the layout. Leave $21 / 4$ " $(6 \mathrm{~cm})$ between the bottom of the "Jolly"letters and the top of the jingle bells for the bow.

8. Follow the stitching chart for stitches and colors. Embroider around the letters and jingle bells.
9. Trim any excess batting and place the 16 " x 21 " ( $41 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ 53 cm ) banner backing on the wrong side of the quilted front.
10. Hand or machine baste around the outside near the edge, securing the layers together.
11. Fuse the $16^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 4$ " $(41 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ 18 cm ) heavy weight fusible interfacing to the wrong side of the $16^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 4^{\prime \prime}(41 \mathrm{~cm} \times 18 \mathrm{~cm})$ pink/gold cotton rectangles.
12. Measure down $1 / 4$ " $(.5 \mathrm{~cm})$ and then over to the center as shown, and cut them in to the triangles for the bottom of the banner.

13. Sandwich the quilted hanging between the two triangles. The triangles need to be right sides together.
14. Stitch along the straight edge as shown.

15. Bring the triangles together and press the seam.
16. Sew the binding strips end to end. Press in half wrong sides together. You need approximately 80 running inches (204cm).
17. Bind the banner mitering corners.
18. A Red Heart ${ }^{\oplus}$ Pom and Tassel tool is helpful when making large tassels plus with this one you will be combining floss and yarn.
19. Wrap the yarn and five or six strands of Anchor Floss around the pegs five or six times.

20. Insert a single strand of floss into the groove in the center which you will use to tie the tassel in the next step.
21. Tie the single strand tightly in a double knot.

22. Remove from the tassel maker by pulling the pegs.
23. Tie an additional strand of floss around the tassel as shown.
24. Trim the bottom of the tassel.

25. Stitch to the bottom of your banner.

## TASSEL ON BANNER

26. To make the twisted cord bows, pull off a 1 yd (. 91 m ) each of one strand of yarn and five or six strands of floss. Tape the end of the cord to a solid surface.
27. Using your fingers, twist the cord multiple times until it is tightly twisted. Hold it firmly in the middle and bring the two ends together letting the strands twist together.


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28. Tie a knot in the each end.
29. Tie in a bow.

30. Repeat to make a second cord. Tie each one in a bow and stitch to the top of the jingle bells.

31. Optional: You can also make a twisted cord for hanging the banner.


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A. Chain stitch $\infty \infty$

In the diagram, the letter refers to the stitch and the number refers to the color. For example, A1 means to the Chain stitch with 0059 China rose

## Anchor Floss - 6 strands

1. 0059 China rose
2. 0975 Sea blue It
3. 0033 Blush med
4. 1002 Antique Gold Lt
5. 0214 Juniper Lt
6. 0031 Blush Lt
7. 0942 Wheat Lt
