Fabric Requirements

This is the final step in completing the Milky Way Wall Hanging.

- Black CSFSESS.BLACK for setting triangles, outer border, and binding
- Saffron CBFS005.SAFFR for sashing
- Radish CSFSESS.RADIS for corner squares
- Royal Blue Marbled CBFS005.ROYAL backing
- Tropical Pink CSFESS.TROPI for inner border
- Batting

Threads

- Coats Dual Duty XP® Paper Piecing thread neutral color
- Coats® Cotton Machine Quilting thread color 813 Over the Rainbow or color of your choice



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Cutting Instructions

CSFSESS.BLACK

5 strips, 3½"x WOF (8.89cm)
1 square, 18¼"x 18¼" (46.36x 46.36cm);
cut in half diagonally twice to yield 4 triangles
2 squares, 9¾"x 9¾" (23.81x 23.81cm);
cut in half diagonally once to yield a total of 4 triangles
5 strips, 2½" (5.72cm) or desired width x WOF,
for binding

CBFS005.SAFFR

16 strips, 1½"x 12½" (3.81 x 31.75cm)

CSFSESS.RADIS

4 squares $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " (3.81 x 3.81cm) 4 squares, $1\frac{1}{8}$ " x $1\frac{1}{8}$ " (4.76 x 4.76cm); cut in half diagonally once to yield a total of 8 triangles

CSFSESS.TROPI

2 strips, 1½"x 37¼" (3.81 x 98.46cm) 2 strips, 1½"x 39¼" (3.81x 98.43cm)

CBFS005.ROYAL - Backing Fabric

2 pieces, 1½ yd (1.37m) x WOF

Assembling the Center

- 1. Using the **quilt layout** as a guide, arrange the star blocks, sashing, cornerstones, and black triangles on a design wall. The small triangles made from the 9%" (23.81cm) squares go in the corners; arrange the large black triangles along the sides.
- Using a ¼" (6mm) seam allowance, sew the pieces together in diagonal rows. Press the seam allowances to one side.
- Sew the rows together to make the quilt center and press.

Adding the Borders


- 1. Sew the 1½"x 37¼" (3.81x 94.62cm) strips of CSFSESS.TROPI to opposite sides of the quilt center. Press the seam allowances toward the border strips.
- 2. Sew the 1½"x 39¼" (3.81x 99.7cm) strips of CSFSESS.TROPI to the top and bottom edges of the quilt center. Press the seam allowances toward the border strips.
- 3. Remove the selvages and sew the 3½" (8.89cm) x WOF strips of CSFSESS.BLACK together to make one long strip. Cut into two 3½"x 39¼" (8.89 x 99.7cm) strips and two 3½"x 45¼" (8.89 x 114.94cm) strips.
- Sew the 3½"x 39¾" (8.89x 99.7cm) strips of CSFSESS.BLACK to opposite sides of the quilt center. Press the seam allowances toward the border strips.
- 5. Sew the 3½"x 45¼" (8.89x 114.94cm) strips of CSFSESS.BLACK to the top and bottom edges of the quilt center. Press the seam allowances toward the border.

Finishing

- 1. Remove the selvages and sew the two pieces of backing fabric together lengthwise to make the backing. Press the seam allowances open.
- 2. Layer the backing, batting, and quilt top. Quilt as desired by hand or machine.
- 3. Trim the backing and batting even with the quilt top.
- 4. Remove the selvages and sew the binding strips together with diagonal seams to form one long strip. Fold the binding in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press. Sew the binding to the right side of the quilt, matching the raw edges and mitering the corners. Turn the folded edge of the binding to the back side of the quilt and stitch in place by hand, enclosing the raw edges and covering the binding seam.



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The blue lines show the diagonal rows for the quilt center.
