CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Ch = Chain(s)

Cont = Continue(ity)

Dc = Double crochet

Hdc = Half double crochet

Hdcbp = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of indicated stitch, inserting hook from back to front to back. (Yoh and draw through 3 loops on hook).

Pat = Pattern

Rem = Remain(ing)

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

Sl st = Slip stitch

Sp(s) = Space(s)

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tog = Together

MATERIALS

Patons® Linen™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 275 yds/251 m)

Cedar (14003)

2 balls or 545 yds/496 m

Size U.S. H/8 [5 mm] Susan Bates® Silvalume™ crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Susan Bates® yarn needle. Susan Bates® stitch markers.

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 11" [28 cm] wide x 12" [30.5 cm] high (excluding handles).

GAUGES

12 hdc and 10 rnds = 4" [10 cm] in pat with 2 strands of yarn held tog.

INSTRUCTIONS

BASE

Notes: Ch 2 at beg of rnd **does not** count as st.

Join rnds with sl st to top of ch 2.

With 2 strands of yarn, ch 31.

Set up rnd: 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each of next 28 ch. 5 hdc in last ch. Working into rem loops of foundation ch, 1 hdc in each ch to last ch. 4 hdc in last ch. Join. 66 hdc.

1st to 4th rnds: Sl st in next hdc. Sl st in sp between last hdc and next hdc. Ch 2. 1 hdc in same sp. *1 hdc in next sp between 2 hdc. Rep from * around, ending with last hdc worked in sp between last hdc and first hdc. Join.

5th rnd (ridge rnd): Ch 2. 1 hdcbp around first hdc. *1 hdcbp around next hdc. Rep from * around. Join.

6th to 15th rnds: Rep 1st to 5th rnds twice more.

Proceed in Shell Pat:

1st rnd: Sl st in next hdc. Sl st in sp between last hdc and next hdc. Ch 3. 1 dc in same sp. *[Skip next sp between 2 hdc. 2 dc in next sp between 2 hdc (shell made)] 5 times. 2 dc in next sp between 2 hdc (shell made). Rep from * to last 10 sps between 2 hdc. [Skip next sp between 2 hdc. 2 dc in next sp between 2 hdc (shell made)] 5 times. Join with sl st in top of ch-3. 36 shells.

2nd rnd: Sl st in next dc. Sl st in next sp between shells. Ch 3. 1 dc in same sp. *2 dc in next sp between 2 shells. Rep from * around. Join with sl st in top of ch-3.

Rep 2nd rnd for Shell Pat until Bag measures approx 12" [30.5 cm] long. Fasten off.

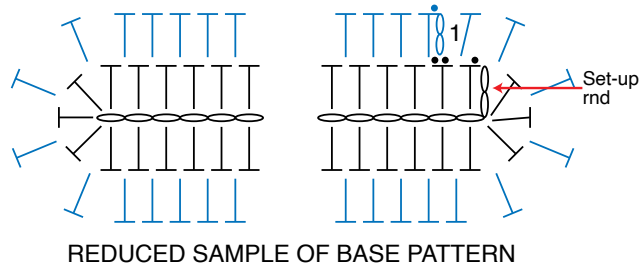
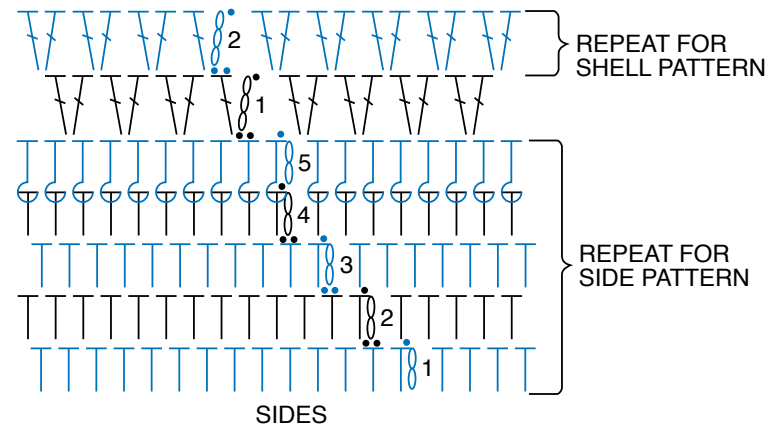
STRAPS (make 2)

With 2 strands of yarn, ch 84, leaving 6" [15 cm] end at beg of chain to attach Strap.

1st row: Turn chain on its side and working into 'bumps' at side of chain, 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn.

2nd row: Sl st in each sc to end of row. Fasten off, leaving 6" [15 cm] end at end of chain to attach Strap.

Sew ends of Straps to inside of Bag approx 8½" [22.5 cm] apart.
