

MATERIALS
Patons ${ }^{\circledR}$ Linen ${ }^{\text {Tm }}$ ( $3.5 \mathrm{oz} / 100 \mathrm{~g} ; 275 \mathrm{yds} / 251 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Cedar (14003)

## 2 balls or $\mathbf{5 4 5}$ yds/496 m

Size U.S. H/8 [5 mm] Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Silvalume ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates ${ }^{\ominus}$ yarn needle. Susan Bates ${ }^{\ominus}$ stitch markers.


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## ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately
Beg $=$ Beginning
Ch = Chain(s)
Cont $=$ Continue(ity)
Dc = Double crochet
Hdc = Half double crochet
Hdcbp = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of indicated stitch, inserting hook from back to front to back. (Yoh and draw through 3 loops on hook).
Pat = Pattern

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 11" [28 cm] wide x 12" [ 30.5 cm ] high (excluding handles).

## GAUGES

12 hdc and $10 \mathrm{rnds}=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in pat with 2 strands of yarn held tog.

Rem = Remain(ing)
Rep $=$ Repeat
Rnd(s) = Round(s)
RS = Right side
$\mathbf{S c}=$ Single crochet
SI st = Slip stitch
Sp(s) = Space(s)
St(s) = Stitch(es)
Tog = Together
WS = Wrong side
Yoh = Yarn over hook

## Yarnspirations <br> spark your inspiration!

Set up rnd: 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each of next 28 ch . 5 hdc in last ch. Working into rem loops of foundation ch, 1 hdc in each ch to last ch. 4 hdc in last ch. Join. 66 hdc.
1st to 4th rnds: Sl st in next hdc. SI st in sp between last hdc and next hdc. Ch 2.1 hdc in same sp. *1 hdc in next sp between 2 hdc. Rep from * around, ending with last hdc worked in sp between last hdc and first hdc. Join.
5th rnd (ridge rnd): Ch 2.1 hdcbp around first hdc. *1 hdcbp around next hdc. Rep from * around. Join.
6th to 15th rnds: Rep 1st to 5th rnds twice more.

## Proceed in Shell Pat:

1st rnd: Sl st in next hdc. Sl st in sp between last hdc and next hdc. Ch 3.1 dc in same sp. *[Skip next sp between 2 hdc. 2 dc in next sp between 2 hdc (shell made)] 5 times. 2 dc in next sp between 2 hdc (shell made). Rep from * to last 10 sps between 2 hdc. [Skip next sp between 2 hdc .2 dc in next sp between 2 hdc (shell made)] 5 times. Join with sl st in top of ch-3. 36 shells.

2nd rnd: SI st in next dc. SI st in next sp between shells. Ch 3.1 dc in same sp. *2 dc in next sp between 2 shells. Rep from * around. Join with sl st in top of ch-3.

Rep 2nd rnd for Shell Pat until Bag measures approx 12 " 30.5 cm ] long. Fasten off.

STRAPS (make 2)
With 2 strands of yarn, ch 84, leaving 6" [15 cm ] end at beg of chain to attach Strap.
1st row: Turn chain on its side and working into 'bumps' at side of chain, 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn.
2nd row: SI st in each sc to end of row. Fasten off, leaving 6 " [15 cm ] end at end of chain to attach Strap.

Sew ends of Straps to inside of Bag approx $81 / 2$ " $[22.5 \mathrm{~cm}]$ apart.


STITCH KEY o = chain (ch)

- = slip stitch (sl st)

T= half double crochet (hdc)
$F=$ double crochet (dc)
I = back post half double
crochet (hdcbp)
