MATERIALS

Patons® Classic Wool Roving™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 120 yds/109 m) Aran (77008) 2 balls

Size U.S. J/10 (5.75-6mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.



Hdcfl = Half double crochet in front loop

only

Hdcf2I = Yoh anddraw up a loop in horizontal bar created by hdc at front of work and front loop in next st. Yoh and draw

through all 3 loops on hook.



Hdcf2|Cluster =

(Yoh and draw up a loop in horizontal bar created by hdc at front of work and front loop) twice in next st. Yoh and draw through all 5 loops

on hook

Pat = Pattern

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

Scf2l = Draw up a loop in horizontal bar created by hdc at front of work and front loop in next st. Yoh and draw

through

Sp(s) = Space(s)**Tog** = Together

Yoh = Yarn over hook



CROCHET I SKILL LEVEL: BEGINNER

SIZES

To fit average lady's hand.

GAUGE

10 sc and 11 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Ch 2 at beg of row does not count as hdc.

Ch 38.

1st row: (RS). 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook and each ch to end of chain. Turn. 36 hdc.

2nd row: Ch 2. 1 hdcf2l in each st to end of row. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 2. *1 hdcf2lCluster in next st. 1 scf2l in next st. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

4th row: Ch 2. *1 hdcfl in next st. 1 hdcf2l in next st. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

5th row: Ch 2. 1 hdcf2l in each st to end of row. Turn.

6th row: As 5th row.

Rep 3rd-6th three times more, ending final rep on 5th row. Fasten off.

Tie off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Sew Foundation chain and last row tog, reversing seam approx 3" [7.5 cm] for turn back. Leaving center 7 sts open for thumb hole. Weave in and out around one end and gather top tog. Pull tightly. Fasten securely.

Note: Thumb is worked as a spiral. No ch are worked at the beg of 2nd - 6th rnds.

Thumb: 1st rnd: With RS facing, join yarn with sl st to st at upper edge of seam opening. Ch 1.

1 hdc in each of next 7 sts. Working across opposite side, 1 hdc in each of next 7 sts.

2nd rnd: 1 hdc in first hdc from 1st rnd. 1 hdc in each of next 6 hdc. Skip next hdc. 1 hdc in each hdc to end of rnd. 13 sts.

Rep 2nd rnd 4 times more. Fasten off.

Weave yarn around top of thumb tog. Pull tightly. Use tail to secure crease and base of thumb. Fasten securely.
