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CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Beg = Begin(ning)(s)

Ch = Chain(s)

Hdc = Half double crochet

Hdcbp = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at back of work, inserting hook from right to left. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook

Hdcfp = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at front of work, inserting hook from right to left. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook

Rem = Remain(ing)(s)

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

Sc = Single crochet

Sc2tog = Draw up a loop in each of next 2 sc. Yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook

Sl st = Slip stitch

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Yoh = Yarn over hook

MATERIALS

Patons® Canadiana™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 205 yds/187 m)

Main Color (MC) Navy (10110) **1 ball**

Contrast A Winter White (10006) **1 ball**

Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
Yarn needle.

SIZE

One size to fit Adult.

GAUGE

14 sc x 17 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- Ch 2 at beg of rnd **does not** count as hdc.
- Join all rnds with sl st to first sc.
