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CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

ABBREVIATIONS

Ch = Chain(s)
Pat = Pattern
Rep = Repeat
RS = Right side
Sc = Single crochet

Scbl = Single crochet in back loop only
Sl st = Slip stitch
St(s) = Stitch(es)
Tog = Together

SIZE

One size to fit Adult.

GAUGE

11 sts and 11 rows = 4" [10 cm] in scbl pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Hat is worked sideways

Ch 42.

1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn. 41 sc.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in first sc. 1 scbl in each sc to last sc. Leave last sc unworked. 40 sts. Turn.

3rd row: Sl st in back loop only of first sc. 1 scbl in next sc. 1 scbl in each sc to end of row. 39 sts. Turn.

4th row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in first sc. 1 scbl in each sc to last sc. Leave last st unworked. 38 sts. Turn.

5th row: Sl st in back loop only of first sc. 1 scbl in next sc. 1 scbl in each sc to end of row. 37 sts. Turn.

6th to 9th rows: As 4th and 5th rows twice more. 33 sts.

MATERIALS

Patons® Norse™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 211 yds /193 m)

Tawny Coral (91008)

1 ball

Size U.S. K/10½ (6.5 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Yarn needle.

10th row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each st to end of row, working into skipped sts and sl sts of previous rows. 41 sc. Turn.

11th to 13th rows: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each st to end of row. Turn.
Rep 2nd to 13th rows 3 times more.
Break yarn leaving a long end.
Thread yarn through side of sts at top of Hat and cinch to close.

FINISHING

With yarn end, sew foundation ch and last row tog. Thread yarn through side of sts at top of Hat and cinch to close.
