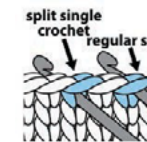

Sc2togspl = Draw up

Tog = Together
WS = Wrong side
Yoh = Yarn over hook

MATERIALS

Patons® Classic Wool Worsted™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 194 yds/177 m)
Contrast A Natural Mix (00229) **1 ball or 85.5yds/78m**
Contrast B Seafoam (77219) **1 ball or 105yds/96m**
Contrast C Rich Raspberry (77783) **1 ball or 31yds/28.5m**
Contrast D Rich Teal (77768) **1 ball or 35yds/32m**
Contrast E Amaranth (77784) **1 ball or 42.5yds/39m**

Size U.S. I/9 (5.5 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Susan Bates® yarn needle. Susan Bates® split stitch marker.

SIZE

One size to fit Adult.

GAUGE

15 sts and 20 rows = 4" [10 cm] in split sc pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: When working from chart, carry yarn not in use loosely across top of work. Work next row over strand of yarn which is not in use. **Do not** join at ends of rnds unless otherwise stated. Cont working in spiral placing marker on first st of rnd for easier counting.

Ribbing: With A, ch 11.

1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch to end of chain. Turn. 10 sc.

2nd row: Ch 1. *Working in back loops only*, 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row until work from beg, when slightly stretched, measures 19½" [49.5 cm].** **Do not** fasten off.

Proceed as follows:

Set-up rnd: Ch 1. Work 80 sc across longer side of ribbing. **Do not** join. PM for beg of rnd.

Cont working in spiral as follows: Beg working Chart, noting 2-st rep will be worked 40 times, *reading rnds from right to left*.

1st rnd: 1 splsc in each sc around. Rep last rnd, and cont working Chart until Rnd 28 of Chart is complete. Break all colors but B.

Shape crown: 1st rnd: *1 splsc in each of next 6 sts. Sc2togspl. Rep from * around. 70 sts.

2nd and alt rnds: 1 splsc in each sc around.

3rd rnd: *1 splsc in each of next 5 sts. Sc2togspl. Rep from * around. Join. 60 sts.

5th rnd: *1 splsc in each of next 4 sts. Sc2togspl. Rep from * around. Join. 50 sts.

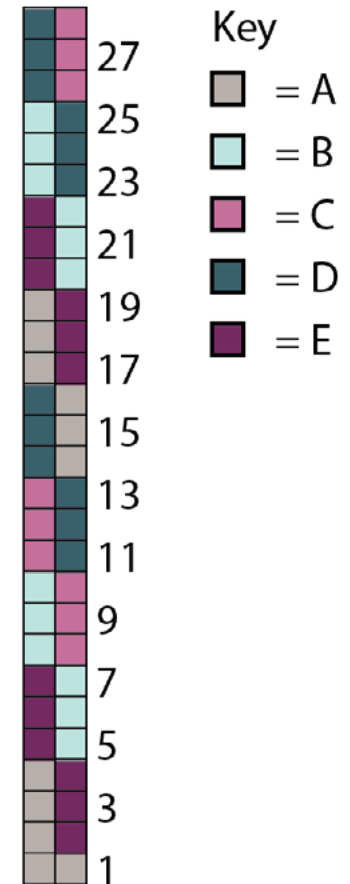
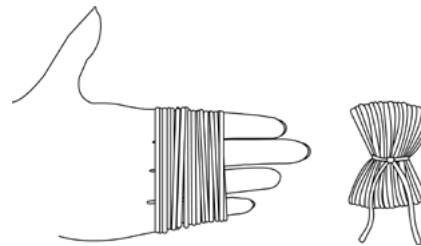
7th rnd: *1 splsc in each of next 3 sts. Sc2togspl. Rep from * around. Join. 40 sts.

9th rnd: *1 splsc in each of next 2 sts. Sc2togspl. Rep from * around. Join. 30 sts.

11 rnd: *1 splsc in next st. Sc2togspl. Rep from * around. Join. 20 sts.

Break yarn, leaving a long end. Thread end through rem sts. Pull tightly. Fasten securely. Sew ends of ribbing together.

Pom-pom: Wind 4 strands of B, 1 strand each A, C, D and E around 4 fingers 40 times. Tie tightly in the middle and leave a long end for attaching to Hat. Cut loops at both ends and trim to smooth round shape. Sew securely to top of Hat.
