APATONS IN THE LOOP SCARF | CROCHET





MEASUREMENTS

Approx 7" [18 cm] wide x 30" [76 cm] long.

GAUGE:

13 sc and 15 rows = 4'' [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Ch 23.

1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of ch. Turn. 22 sc.

2nd row: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 1 dc in each of next 2 sc. *Skip next 2 sc. 5 dc in next sc. Ch 2. Skip next 3 sc.* 1 dc in each of next 4 sc. Rep from * to * once more. 1 dc in each of last 3 sc. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 1 dc in each of next 2 dc. *Skip next ch-2 sp. 5 dc in next dc. Ch 2. Skip next 4 dc.* 1 dc in each of next 4 dc. Rep from * to * once more. 1 dc in each of last 3 dc. Turn.

Rep last row until work from beg measures 26" [66 cm], ending on a WS row.

Loop: Next row: (RS). Ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 3 dc. 2 sc in next ch-2 sp. 1 sc in each of next 9 dc. 2 sc in next ch-2 sp. 1 sc in each of next 8 dc. Turn. 24 sc.

Fold Scarf in half, working through both thicknesses, ch 1. Work 1 sc in each of next 12 sc. Turn. Place marker on last row.

Next row: Ch 2 (does not count as hdc).

1 hdc in each sc across. Turn.

Next row: Ch 2 (does not count as hdc). 1 hdc in each hdc across. Turn.

Rep last row until Loop from marked row measures 8" [20.5 cm]. Fasten off.

Fold last row of Loop to meet marked row. Sew Loop into position.

Bottom edging: Join yarn with sl st to first rem loop of foundation ch.

1st row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each rem loop of foundation ch. Turn. 22 sc.

2nd row: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 4 dc in first sc. SI st in next sc. *5 dc in next sc. SI st in next sc. Rep from * to end of row. Fasten off.

MATERIALS

Patons® Metallic™ Variegates (2.5 oz/70 g; 197 yds/180 m)

Black Marble (97003) 1 ball

Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch marker.
