

PATONS[®] LACE RUFFLES SCARF (TO CROCHET)

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 4×55 ins $[10 \times 139.5 \text{ cm}]$ (when folded along foundation chain).

MATERIALS

Patons® Lace (85 g /3 oz; 455 m/498 yds) Contrast A (33129 Porcelain) 1 ball Contrast B (33008 Vintage) 1 ball

Size 4 mm (U.S. G or 6) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain tension.**

TENSION

 $16\frac{1}{2}$ dc and 9 rows = 4 ins [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

With A, ch 222. (**Note:** Place marker on every 50th ch for easier counting).

1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of ch. Turn. 221 sc.

2nd row: Ch 4 (counts as tr). Working in back loop only of each st, work 2 tr in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**3rd row: Ch 1. Working in both loops, 1 sc in each tr to end of row. Turn.

4th row: Ch 4 (counts as tr). 1 tr in each sc to end of row. Turn.

Rep last 2 rows until work from foundation ch measures approx 4 ins [10 cm], ending with 4th row. Fasten off.**

With RS facing, join B with sl st to first rem loop of sc from 1st row. Ch 4 (counts as tr). Working in rem loop only of each sc, work 2 tr in each sc to end of row. Turn.

Rep from ** to ** as given above.
