



## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 12" [30.5 cm] deep x 90" [228.5 cm] wide along lower edge (excluding edging).

## GAUGE

16 dc and 8 rows = 4" [10 cm].



## MATERIALS

Patons® Kroy Socks™ (1.75 oz/50 g; 166 yds/152 m)

Contrast A Coal (55040)

3 balls

Patons® Kroy Socks FX™ (1.75 oz/50 g; 166 yds/152 m)

Contrast B Casual Colors (57014)

3 balls

Size U.S. G/6 (4 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.

## ABBREVIATIONS:

**Approx** = Approximate(ly)    **Hdc** = Half double crochet    **Sc** = Single crochet

## INSTRUCTIONS

**Note:** To join colors, work last 2 loops of first color, then draw new color through rem 2 loops and proceed.

With A, ch 68.

(See Diagram 1 on page 2).

**1st row:** (RS). 1 dc in 5th ch from hook (counts as dc. Ch 1). \*1 dc in each of next 10 ch. (1 dc. Ch 1. 1 dc) in next ch.\*\* Rep from \* to \*\* once more. 1 dc in each of next 18 dc. (1 dc. Ch 1. 1 dc) in next ch. Rep from \* to \*\* twice more. Turn.

**2nd row:** Ch 4 (counts as 1 dc. Ch 1). 1 dc in first ch-1 sp. \*1 dc in each of next 12 dc. (1 dc. Ch 1. 1 dc) in next ch-1 sp.\*\* Rep from \* to \*\* once more. 1 dc in each of next 20 dc. (1 dc. Ch 1. 1 dc) in next ch-1 sp. Rep from \* to \*\* twice more. Join B. Turn.

**3rd row:** With B, ch 4 (counts as 1 dc. Ch 1). 1 dc in first ch-1 sp. \*1 dc in each of next 14 dc. (1 dc. Ch 1. 1 dc) in next ch-1 sp.\*\* Rep from \* to \*\* once more. 1 dc in each of next 22 dc. (1 dc. Ch 1. 1 dc) in next ch-1 sp. Rep from \* to \*\* twice more. Turn.

**4th row:** Ch 4 (counts as 1 dc. Ch 1). 1 dc in first ch-1 sp. \*1 dc in each of next 16 dc. (1 dc. Ch 1. 1 dc) in next ch-1 sp.\*\* Rep from \* to \*\* once more. 1 dc in each of next 24 dc. (1 dc. Ch 1. 1 dc) in next ch-1 sp. Rep from \* to \*\* twice more. Join A. Turn.

Cont as established, inc 2 more dc between each (1 dc. Ch 1. 1 dc) every row, and working 2 rows each in A and B until there are 68 dc between each side (1 dc. Ch 1. 1 dc) section, and 76 dc in center section, ending with 2 rows of A. Fasten off.

**Side edging:** With RS facing, join B with sl st to first rem loop of foundation ch at left edge. Ch 1. Work 1 row of sc evenly along left side edge of Shawl to last row worked. Fasten off. Rep for other side.

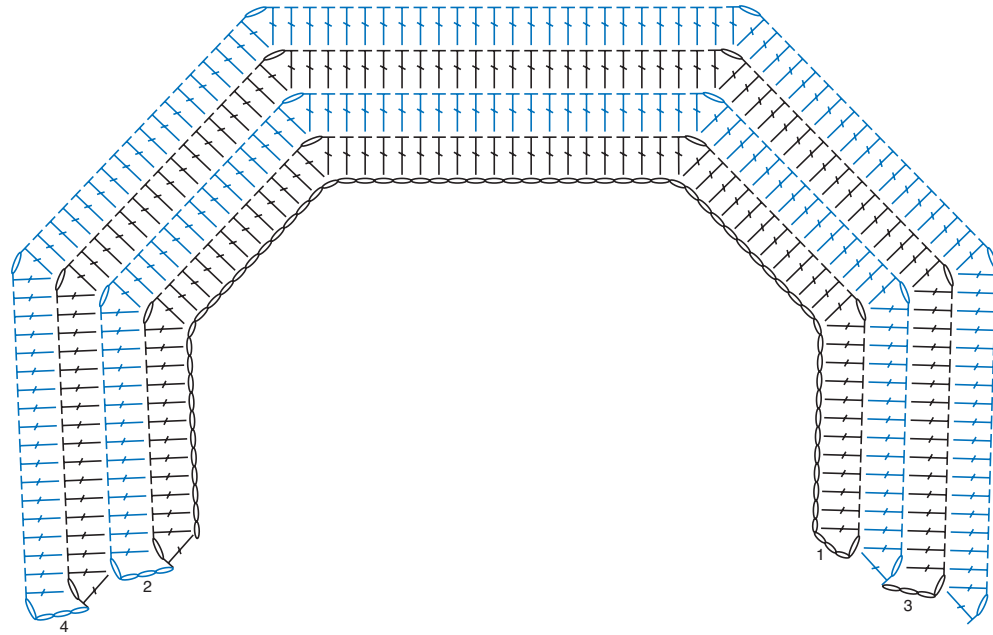
**Fringe:** (See Diagram 2 on page 2). With RS facing, join B with sl st to first dc of last row. Ch 1. 1 sc in first dc. \*Ch 9. Yoh and draw up a loop in 4th ch from hook. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops) 3 times. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook - cluster made. 1 hdc in same ch as cluster. Sl st in each of next 5 ch. 1 sc in each of next 4 dc. Rep from \* to end of row. Fasten off.

Block piece to measurements.

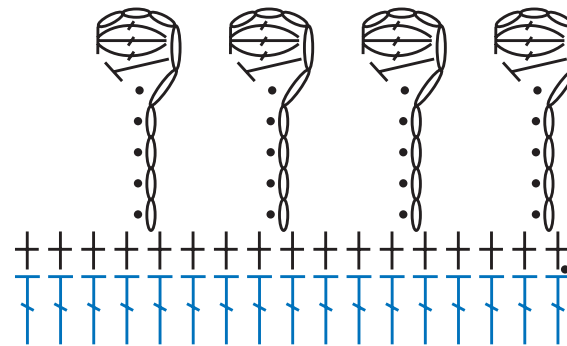
**KEY**
