

## **Patons GLOBETROTTER SHAWL** | CROCHET

Worked lengthwise in 3 strips. Outer strips use Bruges lace technique. Center strip of dc and puff stitches joins 2 outer strips as you work along foundation chain and last row.



### **MATERIALS**

**Patons® Kroy Socks FX™** (1.75 oz/50 g; 166 yds/152 m)

Contrast A Canyon Colors (57609) 4 balls **Contrast B** Cowboy Colors (57013) 4 balls Contrast C Casual Colors (57014) 3 balls

Size U.S. F/5 (3.75 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS:**

**Approx** = Approximately **Beg** = Beginning Ch = Chain(s)

**Dc** = Double crochet

Dtr = (Yoh) 3 times and drawup a loop in indicated space.

(Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) 4 times -

Double Treble made.

**Puff st** = (Yoh and draw up a long loop) 3 times in indicated space. Yoh and draw through all but last loop on hook. Yoh and draw through rem 2 loops on

**Hdc** = Half double crochet

hook - Puff st made.

**Rem** = Remain(ing)

Rep = Repeat

**RS** = Right side

**Sc** = Single crochet

SI st = Slip stitch **Sp** = Space

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

#### **MEASUREMENTS**

Approx 18" x 70" [45.5 x 178 cm], excluding fringe.

**GAUGE:** 20 dc and 10 rows = 4'' [10 cm].

### **INSTRUCTIONS**

BRUGES LACE STRIP (Make 2).

(See Diagram 1 on page 3).

form ring.

**1st row:** Ch 6. 1 dc in first ch of ring. (Ch 1. Skip next ch. 1 dc in next ch) twice. Turn, leaving rem 8 ch of ring unworked.

2nd row: Ch 6. 1 dc in first dc. (1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in next dc) twice. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 6. 1 dc in first dc. (Ch 1. Skip next dc. 1 dc in next dc) twice. Turn.

4th row: As 2nd row. **5th row:** As 3rd row.

**6th row:** Ch 6. 1 tr in first dc. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in next dc. 1 hdc in next ch-1 sp. 1 sc in next dc. Turn.

7th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. Ch 1. Skip next hdc. 1 dc in next dc. Ch 1. Skip next dc. 1 tr in next tr. Turn.

8th row: Ch 6. 1 tr in first tr. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in next dc. 1 hdc in next ch-1 sp. 1 sc in next sc. Turn.

9th to 12th rows: As 7th and 8th rows twice more.

**13th row:** Ch 3. Sl st in ch-6 sp of adjacent row. Ch 3. 1 dc in first sc. Ch 1. Skip next st. 1 dc in next dc. Ch 1. Skip next st. 1 dc in next tr. Turn.

14th row: Ch 6. 1 dc in first dc. (1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in next dc) twice. Turn.

**15th row:** Ch 3. SI st in ch-6 sp of adjacent row. Ch 3. 1 dc in first dc. (Ch 1. Skip next dc. 1 dc in next dc) twice. Turn.

With A, ch 13. Join with sl st to first ch to **16th row:** Ch 6. 1 dc in first dc. (1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in next dc) twice. Turn.

> **17th row:** Ch 3. Sl st in ch-6 sp of adjacent row. Ch 3. 1 tr in first dc. Ch 1. Skip next dc. 1 dc in next dc. Ch 1. Skip next dc. 1 sc in next dc. Turn.

> **18th row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. 1 hdc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in next dc. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 tr in next tr. Turn.

> 19th row: Ch 6. 1 tr in first tr. Ch 1. Skip next dc. 1 dc in next dc. Ch 1. Skip next hdc. 1 sc in next sc. Turn.

> 20th to 23rd rows: As 18th and 19th rows twice more.

> **24th row:** Ch 3. Sl st in ch-6 sp of adjacent row. Ch 3. 1 dc in first sc. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in next dc. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in in next tr. Turn.

> **25th row:** Ch 6. 1 dc in first dc. (Ch 1. Skip next dc. 1 dc in next dc) twice. Turn.



## **APATONS** GLOBETROTTER SHAWL | CROCHET

**26th row:** Ch 3. SI st in ch-6 sp of adjacent row. Ch 3. 1 dc in first dc. (1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in in next dc) twice. Turn.

27th row: As 25th row.

**28th row:** Ch 3. SI st in ch-6 sp of adjacent row. Ch 3. 1 tr in first dc. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in in next dc. 1 hdc in next ch-1 sp. 1 sc in next dc. Turn.

Rep 7th to 28th rows 18 times more, then 7th to 16th rows once.

**Next row:** Ch 3. Sl st in ch-6 sp of adjacent row. Ch 3. 1 dc in first dc. (Ch 1. Skip next dc. 1 dc in next dc) twice. Turn.

**Next row.** Ch 8. Skip next 4 dc. Sl st in next dc. Fasten off.

Finished strip will have 20 curves at top edge and 19 curves at bottom edge.

### **CENTER STRIP**

#### Notes:

- Center Strip is joined directly to first Bruges Lace Strip at foundation chain, and second Bruge Lace Strip at last row.
- Before joining, position RS of Bruges Lace Strip facing with beg and end points pointing down as shown in Assembly Diagram.

## **Joining 1st Bruges Lace Strip:**

(See Diagram 1 "Begin Center Strip" on page 3).

Joining chain: With B, ch 5. SI st in first ch-6 sp of Bruges Lace Strip. Ch 5. SI st in next ch-6 sp of Bruges Lace Strip. \*Ch 5. 1 dtr in next sp between 2 joined ch-6 sps of Bruges Lace Strip. Ch 5. 1 sI st in next ch-6 sp of Bruges Lace Strip. Ch 5. 1 sI st in next ch-6 sp of Bruges Lace Strip. Rep from \* 19 times. Ch 7. Turn.

(See Diagram 2 on page 4).

**1st row:** (WS). 1 dc in 4th ch from hook (skipped ch-3 counts as dc). 1 dc in each of next 3 ch. 1 dc in next ch-6 sp of Bruges Lace Strip. 5 dc in next ch-5 sp. 1 dc in next ch-6 sp of Bruges Lace Strip. \*5 dc in next ch-5 sp. 1 dc in next dtr. 5 dc in next ch-5 sp. 1 dc in next ch-6 sp of Bruges Lace Strip. 5 dc in next ch-5 sp. 1 dc in next ch-6 sp of Bruges Lace Strip. Rep from \* to last 5 ch. 1 dc in each of next 5 ch. 359 sts. Turn.

**2nd row:** (RS). Ch 4 (counts as 1 dc and ch-1 sp). Skip next dc. 1 dc in next dc. \*Ch 1. Skip next dc. 1 dc in next dc. Rep from \* across. Turn.

**3rd row:** (WS). Ch 3 (counts as dc). 1 dc in each dc and Ch-1 sp across. Fasten off. **Do not** turn.

With **WS** facing, join C to top of ch-3 at beg of 3rd row.

4th row: (WS). With C, ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 3 dc. \*Ch 2. Skip next 2 dc. (1 dc. Ch 2. 1 dc) in next dc. Ch 2. Skip next 2 dc. 1 sc in next dc. Rep from \* to last 2 dc. 1 sc in each of last 2 dc. Turn.

**5th row:** Ch 4 (counts as tr). 1 tr in each of next 2 sc. Skip next ch-2 sp. [(Puff st. Ch 2) twice. Puff st] in next ch-2 sp. \*Ch 1. Skip next 2 ch-2 sps. [(Puff st. Ch 2) twice. Puff st] in next ch-2 sp. Rep from \* to last 3 sc. 1 tr in each of last 3 sc. Fasten off. Turn.

6th row: Join B with sl st to first tr. Ch 3 (counts as dc). 1 dc in each of next 2 tr. (1 dc in next puff st. 1 dc in next ch-2 sp) twice. 1 dc in next puff st. \*1 dc in next ch-1 sp. (1 dc in next puff st. 1 dc in next ch-2 sp) twice. 1 dc in next puff st. Rep from \* to last 3 tr. 1 dc in each of last 3 tr. Turn.

Rep 2nd to 6th rows 3 times more, then 2nd row once more.

## Join 2nd Bruges Lace Strip:

Position 2nd Bruges Lace Strip as seen in Assembly Diagram.




**Next row:** Ch 3 (counts as dc). (1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in next dc) twice. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. Sl st in first ch-6 sp of Bruges Lace Strip. (1 dc in next dc. 1 dc in next

ch-1 sp) 3 times. SI st in next ch-6 sp of Bruges Lace Strip. \*(1 dc in next dc. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp) 3 times. Ch 5. SI st in next sp between 2 joined ch-6 sps of Bruges Lace Strip. 1 sI st in each of last 5 chs. [(1 dc in next dc. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp) 3 times. SI st in next ch-6 sp of Bruges Lace Strip] twice. Rep from \* to last 5 sts. (1 dc in next dc. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice. 1 dc in last dc. Fasten off.

### Fringe

Cut strands of A, B and C each 24" [61 cm] long. Taking one strand of each shade tog, fold in half and knot into fringe across short ends of Shawl. Trim fringe evenly.








